Open until July 26th, 2024


The registration fee is USD 100. It is subsidized by Wikimedia Foundation to cover all the events, meals, and swag. Scholars will be waived with special registration code.


How to Reach the Venue

From ICC Katowice to <u>Silesian</u> <u>Museum</u>: around 10 minutes walk




Floor Plan

What should I prepare?

- How much money should I bring? It depends!
 - Most of the merchants will accept Visa/Master cards
 - Local currency is PLN/Polish Zloty.
- Pack your medicine according to your needs and prepare the label/doctor notes in your carry on bag
- On average day is 25°C (76°F) and at night 13°C (55°F), although it can occasionally get hotter, reaching more than 30°C (86°F) lightweight clothes, lightweight jacket, umbrella, cap or hat and sunscreen are advisable to bring!
- Wear the comfortable shoes as you may need to walk a lot in this lovely city!

Act Like Polish People 101

Food: Try pierogi, singular pierog (especially the seasonal ones with blueberries), żurek (a soup made of soured rye flour), zapiekanka (Polish street food – baked baguette with cheese and mushrooms), jagodzianka (a traditional Polish blueberry sweet bun), pączek (doughnut), sernik (cheesecake)
Drink: Kompot (sweet beverage made with fruit)
Visit: Katowice Rondo
What to Learn – simple Polish, walk in right (be careful of tram and scooter)

A related concept is a code of conduct, which is a policy guiding behavior in all contexts, and not only at in-person events as a friendly space policy does.

General friendly space policy for Wikimedia events

The Wikimedia community is dedicated to providing a welcoming experience for everyone, regardless of gender, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, appearance, race, religion, or preferred free license (and not limited to those aspects). We do not tolerate harassment of event participants. Participants violating these rules may be asked to leave the event at the discretion of the event organizers.
