FROM: Mr. Roosevelt

- 1. On 10 October the Shah gave audience which lasted one and one half hours to General Hedayatollah Guilanshah, who is now very close to Prime Minister Zahedi.
- 2. The Shah was worried over revival of the National Front and asked if the British were backing it.
- 3. Guilanshah urged the Shah to remain at Saadabad Palace for two months until the Tudeh threat has been eliminated. The Shah refused.
- 4. Guilanshah told the Shah that Chief of Staff General Batmangelich and Military Governor of Tehran General Dadsetan have been feuding and that on 9 October Batmangelich had asked Dadsetan to resign. The Shah said that he would summon both of them and order them to cooperate.
- 4. Guilanshah gave the Shah plan for reducing the Air Force personnel to a level consonant with the amount of equipment on hand and projected. The Shah said that he would study the plan.
