" " " Machinery.....	4. 3. 0

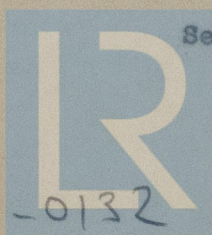
You will therefore be good enough to see that the necessary entries are now made in your Rough Fee and Debit Books accordingly.
