A SPECIAL to the Constitution anexcurred the death of ex-Governor H. V. Johnson, who died at his home near Wadley. Gr., on the 17th inst., in the sixty-eighth year of his age. He was Presidential elector and Judge in 1844, United States Senator in 1848, and "Governor of Georgia from 1853 to 1857. He was also the Democratic candidate for Vice-President with Douglass in 1860, and a member of the secession convention is Georgia when he opposed vigorously the policy of leaving the Union. In 1863 he was elected to the Contederate States Seaste and presided war the State Constitutional Convention a 1863. In 1866 he was elected Haired States Senate, but was not permented to take his sent, In 1873 he e es ed the Superior Court Judge rinch position to beld at the time
