# Present ideas to each other, cluster and vote on favorite ideas


2 min per person, 5 min clustering, 5 min voting 3 dots per person (20 minutes in total)



## Create prototype / concept for favorite idea


Be as visual as possible. What would a UI look like if there is one? What would an architecture look like? Who are the users? How would you interact with it? (20 minutes)
