Silent Brainstorming

In groups of 3-4 people. 10 Minutes.

(15 minutes in total)

Silent brainstorming again. 10 Minutes.

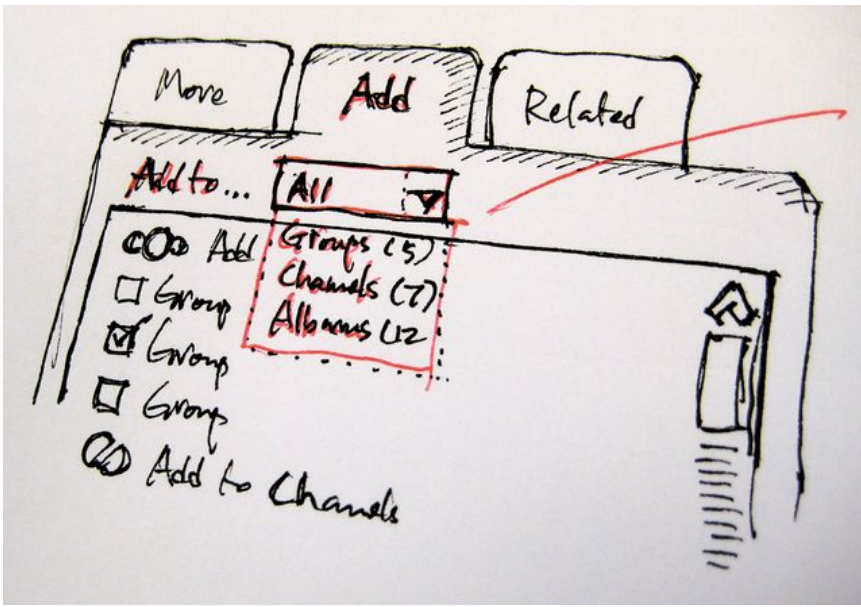
Create prototype / concept for favorite idea

(20 minutes)

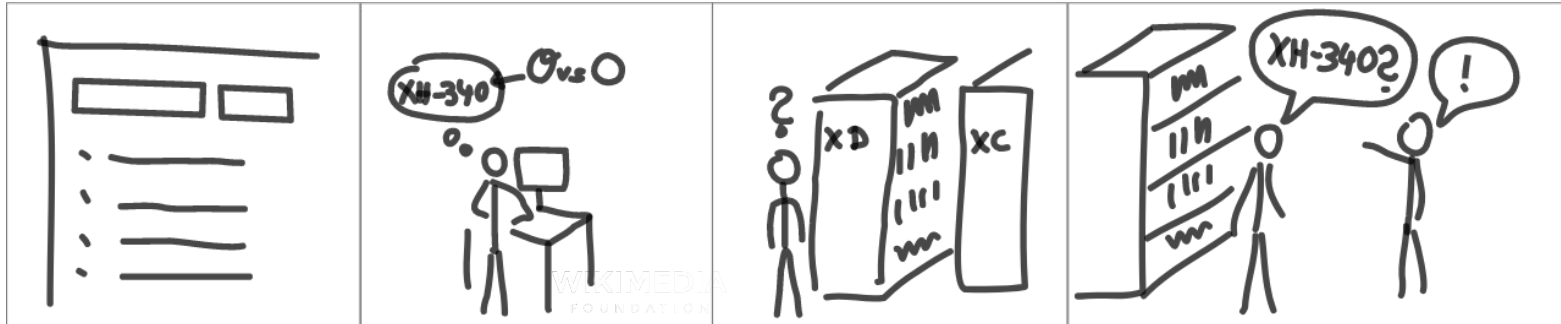
