TO : Head Netherlands Military Mission for Japan.

1. Reference your letter, file No.:M.3-33, 29 May 1946, subject: "Reparations", attached hereto is a copy of Revised List No. 1 of aircraft plants, arsenals and laboratories that have been taken into custody and control by the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

2. An inventory of equipment is now being made and results thereof will be forwarded to The Far Eastern Commission in Washington.

3. The question of allocation or distribution of items under reparations is a matter for inter-governmental decision.
