The following individuals, with a few exceptions, were official Japanese delegates to the Seventh Biennial Conference of the World Federation of Education Associations held in Tokyo, 2-7 August 1937.

The Biennial World Educational Conference had its inception in San Francisco in 1923, subsequently holding gatherings in Toronto, Geneva, Denver, Lublin and Oxford. The Seventh Biennial World Educational Conference was attended by approximately nine hundred educators of thirty-eight foreign countries and nearly twenty-five hundred Japanese leaders of educational work in Japan. The Japan Education Association acted as host to the delegates, and the preparatory work took more than a year.

Source material for this collation is the record of proceedings (five volumes) of the Conference. Because of the lapse of time, many of the addresses and occupational affiliations of the delegates as given are undoubtedly incorrect as of this time. Many of the delegates may, in fact, no longer be living.

However, this is the most comprehensive list of Japanese educators made available to DIO-14ND, and this report has been prepared with the thought that Japanese educators as a class may be one of the social groups most useful to occupation authorities.

To obviate the necessity for repetitious printing or unnecessary tabulation, the following explanation is given. The information on each individual is set forth in this manner:
