COPY OF SECTION 3 OF LAW 27 OF 1873 What is an unlawful Assembly.

Whenever and wherever this Law applies, it shall be unlawful for j more than four persons to assemble in any building or at any place, in or near to which any person is then lying dead, or within any building in which any person has died within four days before such assembling: ' Provided, that in counting, for the purposes of this law, the number of persons at any assemblage in any building, the persons actually residing in such building at the time of the death of such person shall be excluded from computation: And provided further, that this section, shall not apply to any assemblage while accompanying a dead body that is being carried to the grave, or while present during the internment of any dead body.
