Department Attorney John J. Cassidy, Criminal Division, Department of Justice, has advised that information concerning this matter was given to him originally on a confidential basis by George Phillips, leader of the dissident group within Teamsters Local 560. Phillips said this information was received by him from a woman whose name he addid not disclose, who is employed as an accountant by Chapman Boat Works. So far as Mr. Cassidy knows neither Phillips nor his source is aware of the present whereabouts of the "Miss Kensington" which reportedly was moved from Chapman Boat Works by Salvatore Briguglio, business agent of Teamsters Local 560.

It is suggested that information concerning the owner of this boat and possibly information with respect to its present location may be available through the Coast Guard, since it is believed Coast Guard regulations require that boats of the reported size of the "Miss Kensington" be registered with that agency.

Department Attorney Cassidy has requested that no contact be made with George Phillips at this time nor should any investigation be conducted to identify the above-mentioned employee of Chapman Boat Works who reportedly was the source of Phillips' information. If the present whereabouts of the "Miss Kensington" cannot be determined infough contact with the Coast Guard or
