Dormant Roses

The following complete assortment of Roses are all No. 1, carefully graded and tied in bundles of five, For Spring delivery. Note: H. P. indicates Hybrid Perpetual, (H. T.) Hybrid Tea, (Poly) Polyanthus, (Cl. T.) Climbing Tea, (H. Ch.) Hybrid China, (C. H. T.) Climbing Hybrid Tea, (H. W.) Hybrid Wichuriana, (T.) Tea, (Bour.) Bourbon.

Black Prince (H. P.)

Velvety crimson with shadings of purplish black. Upright, strong growth.

Cecile Brunner (Poly.)

Dainty, tiny miniature roses of delicate bisque pink. Beautiful long pointed buds. Vigorous, low-spreading.

Cl. Baby Rambler (Poly.)

An everblooming true Crimson Rambler. Foliage never mildews, always clean and bright.

Cl. Captain Christy (H. T.)

Large, full, double blossoms of most delicate pink, shading deeper in center.

Cl. Caroline Testout (Cl. T.)

Vigorous climber. Large cup-shaped blooms. Delicate pink.

Cl. Helen Gould (Cl. T.)

A perfect Helen Gould that is a strong climber.

Cl. Wooton (Cl. T.)

Good red climbers. Blooms large and full.

Cl. Killarney (Cl. H. T.)

Like Killarney except that it is a vigorous climber; deep shell-pink.

Dorothy Perkins (H. W.)

Clear shell-pink flowers, profusely borne in clusters; full and double, with crinkled petals.

Etoile De Lyon (T.)

Beautiful chrome-yellow. Pure golden center.

Eugene Marlitt (Bour.)

Flowers large, very double, a rich, bright crimson; fragrant.

Cl. Gruss An Teplitz (H. Ch.)

A vigorous climber. A perfect sheet of dazzling crimson when in bloom.

Magna Charta (H. P.)

Extra large, full flowers of unusual depth; bright rosy-pink in color.

J. B. Clark (H. P.)

Intense flaming scarlet. Well-formed cup-shaped.

Gen. Jacqueminot (H. P.)

Bright, shining crimson, very fragrant, free bloomer.

Mad. Jules Grolez (H. T.)

Bright rich, rosy red blooms of splendid substance on good stiff stems. Spreading habit.

Margaret Dickson (H. P.)

White with delicate flesh center. Best of white perpetuals. Vigorous, upright.

Maman Cochet (Pink) (T.)

Rosy-pink, shadings of silvery-rose.

Maman Cochet (White) (T.)

Of same habits as Pink Cochet, best pearly-white.

Paul Neyron (H. P.)

Deep, rosy-pink, full, double blooms with spicy fragrance, borne on strong upright stems.

Frau Karl Druschki (H. P.)

One of the purest white roses known. Sometimes known as Snow Queen. Very large blooms.

Radiance

Pink, darker on the inner surface of the petals than on the margin.

Reine Marie Henrietta (Cl. T.)

Bright, cherry-red. Delicately scented. Vigorous climber and good bloomer.

Wellesley (H. T.)

Pink, outside of petals being very bright pink in color and reverse of silvery shadings. Upright.
