

On the way to my Quarters in Quonset Hut number two(2), I tripped on the stones that are between the club and the shower room, falling so that the weight of my body forced my thumb under the palm of my hand. When I got up I went to my hat. After a while I noticed a swelling of the thumb. I thought it was a sprain. On the 10th of January it began to hurt very much so I reported on sick call and went to the 118th Station Hospital. Further the deponent sayeth not.
