My dear Mr. Weingartner:

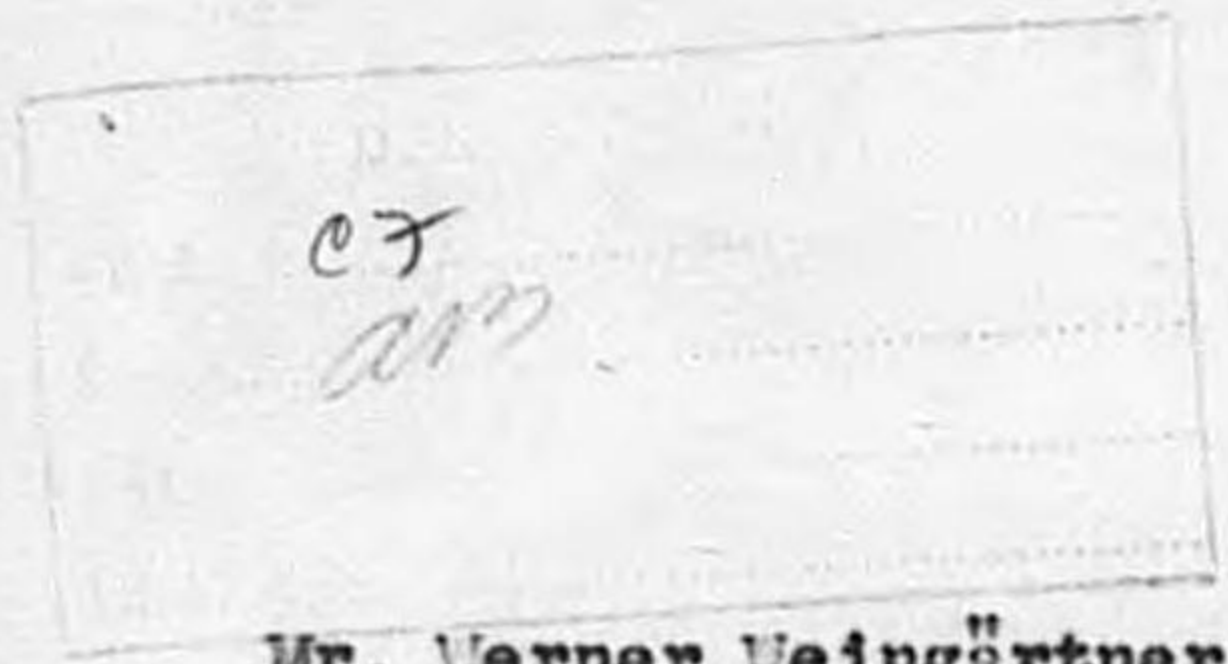
