SUMMARY:

1. By letter, dated 21 July 1945, Mr. Grew, Acting Secretary of State, advises that Secretary of War of request received by the the State Department from the Canadian Ambassador that membership on the Supply Subcommittee of the CCAC be expanded to include a civilian member of his staff. The State Department has informed the Canadian Ambassador that they are in complete agreement with his proposal and ask the War Department to give immediate consideration to this request.

2. On 30 July 1945, the Secretary of War notified the Secretary of State that the Canadian proposal was being referred to the Joint Chiefs of Staff for reconsideration.

3. Decision has been received from the Joint Chiefs of Staff approving the addition of a member from the Canadian Embassy on the Committee and recommending that the Secretary of War forward the attached draft letter to the Secretary of State.


