

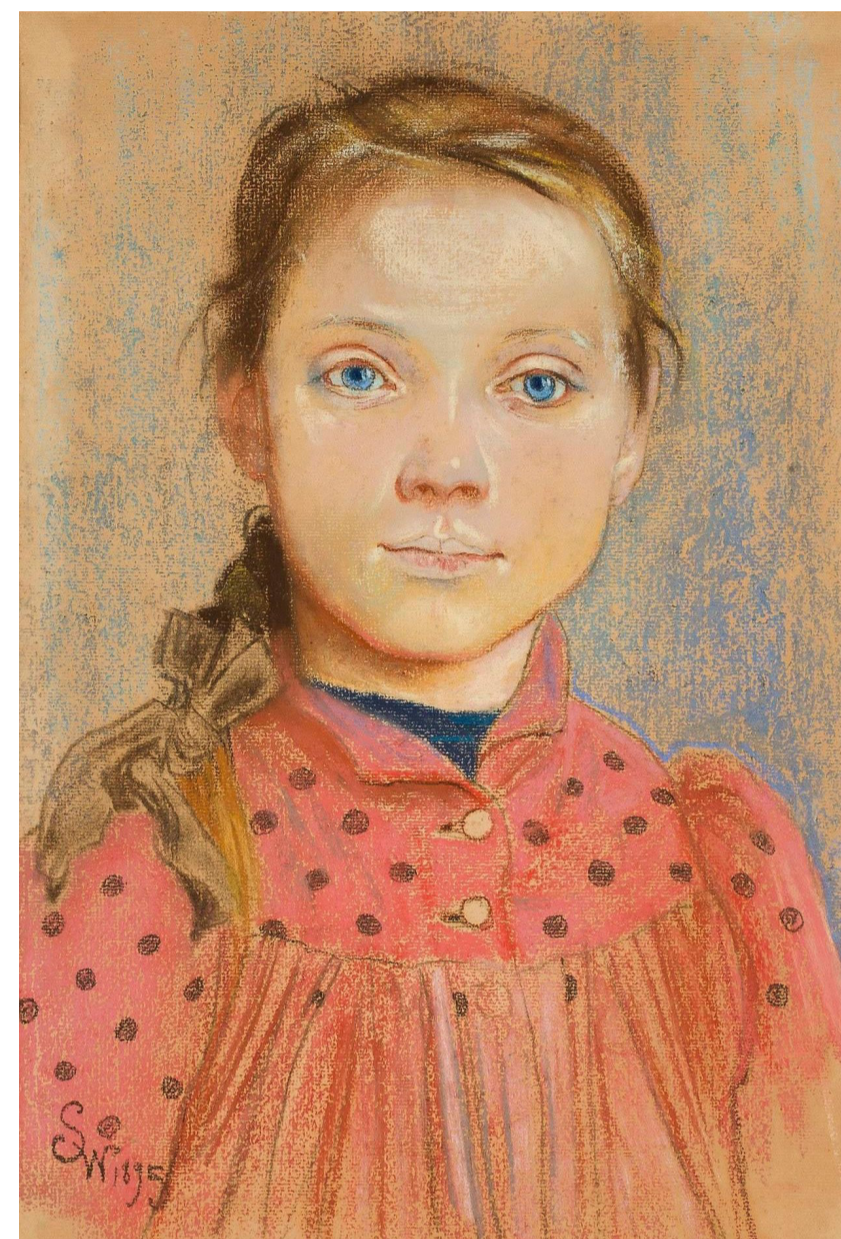

Wikipedian-in-Residence



The NMW contributes handpicked images of the most valuable and unique artworks from its Collection to Wikimedia Commons.

A Wikipedian-in-Residence works with staff and volunteers. The NMW residency in 2016 is the **first WiR funded by a public cultural institution** in Poland.

Around 300 images uploaded so far have been **reused more than 1500 times in over 80 Wikimedia projects**.

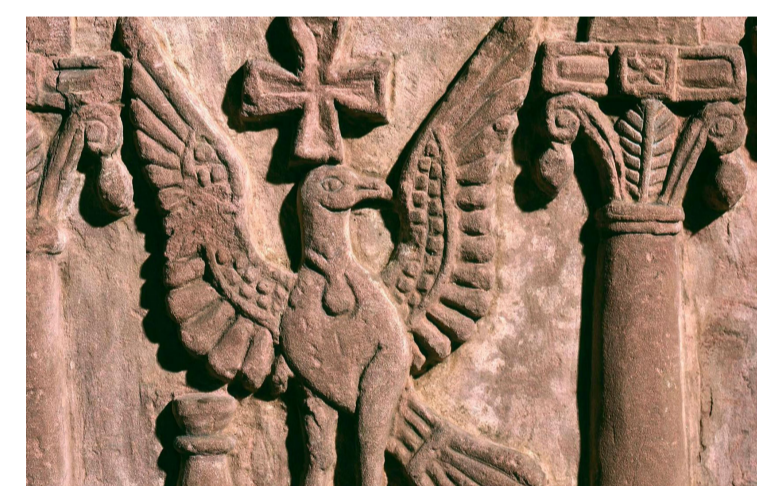

The Ritual Year with Wikipedia

The Ritual Year with Wikipedia combined **source material research (content) with field research (images)**.



Teams consisting of Wikipedians, Museum staff and students filmed and photographed unique regional customs, released around 1000 resulting media on Wikimedia Commons, then wrote over 40 illustrated articles on several language versions of Wikipedia.

State Archives and Senate

Contributions and competitions

The State Archives in Poznan, State Archives in Lodz, the Senate of Poland and the Central Archives of Historical Records have uploaded a **total of around 5000 images** to Commons.

Dust off a Document!, an illustrating contest, saw **over 150 Wikipedia articles illustrated by previously unused images** contributed by the State Archive in Poznan.

Burszta Archives

A complete faculty image archive available on Wikimedia Commons

The Adam Mickiewicz University's Institute of Ethnography has contributed the entire Józef Burszta Digital Archive, devoted to Polish and international ethnographic studies: **8000 photographs** – to Wikimedia Commons.
