

Gabriel José de la Concordia García Márquez (American Spanish: [gaˈβɾiɛl xaɾ'si.a ˈmärkɛz]) [audio](#) ([help/info](#)); 6 March 1927 – 17 April 2014) was a [Colombian](#) novelist, short-story writer, screenwriter and journalist, known affectionately as **Gabo** throughout Latin America. Considered one of the most significant authors of the 20th century, he was awarded the 1972 [Neustadt International Prize for Literature](#) and the 1982 [Nobel Prize in Literature](#).^[1] He pursued a self-directed education that resulted in his leaving law school for a career in journalism. From early on, he showed no inhibitions in his criticism of Colombian and foreign politics. In 1958, he married Mercedes Barcha; they had two sons, [Rodrigo](#) and Gonzalo.^[2]

García Márquez started as a journalist, and wrote many acclaimed non-fiction works and short stories, but is best known for his novels, such as [One Hundred Years of Solitude](#) (1967), [The Autumn of the Patriarch](#) (1975) and [Love in the Time of Cholera](#) (1985). His works have achieved significant critical acclaim and widespread commercial success, most notably for popularizing a literary style labeled as [magic realism](#), which uses magical elements and events in otherwise ordinary and realistic situations. Some of his works are set in a fictional village called [Macondo](#) (the town mainly inspired by his birthplace [Aracataca](#)), and most of them explore the theme of [solitude](#).


