TYPIC

5. On 15 March 1963, Mariano GARCIA Perez, Cuban Consul in Merida, left Mexico City for Havana via Cubana Airlines (LIPIRE B/DOC).

6. On 22 March 1963, GARCIA returned to Mexico City from Havana via Cubana Airlines (LIPIRE B/DOC).

7. On 22 March 1963, LITAMIL-7 reported that GARCIA had replaced Ramiro ALFILIR Lopez, Cuban Consul in Mexico, who left Mexico for Havana on 22 March 1963. ACCUS, who went to Havana on vacation, is scheduled to return in about a month. LITAMIL-7 that his wife would join him in Havana in about two weeks. LITAMIL-7 recently told LITAMIL-3 that ACCUS's wife would refuse to return to Cuban with him.

8. Attached, for Base Merida, is a photograph of GARCIA obtained through the LIBROK operation and identified by (LITAMIL-7).
