


Challenges & Observations

- We still don't have a large active community
- Outreach has mostly been to existing Wikimedians
 - Advantages: Easy to adopt, more chances for retention
 - Disadvantages: Not easy to adopt, kills their contributions on other projects
- Editors are highly active during campaigns only, but are not consistently contributing after it is over.
 - Campaigns can only happen occasionally, but not all the time
- Linguistically diverse community spread over a huge geographical region.









Wikicamp 2018.
