The following information, subject as above, received by check note from the Comptroller, Far East Command, 13 August 1951, is quoted for your information and guidance.

1. Reference is made to Far East Command Circular No. 25, Subject: Travel, Temporary Duty and Station Allowances, 30 May 1951.
2. Section Chiefs will be guided by the following in authorizing per diem for travel in Japan:
 - a. Per diem should be prescribed only when there is an expense over and above the normal everyday living expense. Service charges at Government messes and billets are to be considered normal living expenses.
 - b. Per diem should not ordinarily be authorized when individual is on a travel status.
 - c. Per diem should not ordinarily be paid while individual is in attendance at service schools or attending field maneuvers."
