

WIKIPEDIA IS AN ENCYCLOPEDIA

- ☐ No original research
- ☐ There is a style form for the text
- Everything does not fit in an encyclopedia, there is a notability criteria

EDITORS SHOULD TREAT EACH OTHER WITH RESPECT AND CIVILITY

- Respect your fellow wikipedians, even when you don't agree
- ☐ Never use Wikipedia as a battleground

FREE CONTENT THAT ANYONE CAN USE, EDIT AND DISTRIBUTE

- All users license their work under free license, so anyone can use it even for commercial reasons
- Plagiarizing from other sources is forbidden and controlled

A NEUTRAL POINT OF VIEW

- ☐ Wikipedia characterize information and issues rather than debate them, presenting different opinions where such exist
- □ No commercials of any kind

WIKIPEDIA HAS NO FIRM RULES

- WIKIPEDIA
 Den fria encyklopedin
- There are policies and guidelines, but they are always open for discussion
- ☐ The principles and spirit is what matters
- ☐ Be bold!



Conflict of interest

- One of the trickiest aspects
- Remember:
 - Neutral point of view
 - o Be open with who you are
 - Use the Talk pages for input and help
 - o Citation, citation



Style

- Remember it is an encyclopedia for *every* one
- ☐ Write for the future reader, avoiding undefined time marks such as "recently"
- ☐ Follow established language norms (or discuss this on Talk pages)
- ☐ Disposition:
 - ☐ Introduction that concludes the topic
 - ☐ Main text divided with headlines
 - ☐ External links, See also
 - □ References
 - Categories














Whyme?

"I slowly got more addicted," said Nijsse, who recently submitted a Ph.D. thesis in mathematics at the University of Exeter's climate systems group."


