POINTS OF INTEREST IN NEW YORK CITY

THE EMPIRE STATE BUILDING is the tallest office building in the world and is situated at 5th Avenue between 33rd and 34th Streets. The site is nearly 2 acres and rises 102 stories above the ground and is 2 stories under the ground. It houses more than 25,000 tenants. Its elevators rise at the tremendous speed of 200 feet per second. While its express cars carry one to the 80th floor in one minute.

ELLIS ISLAND is the first landing place of the immigrant and is located in the upper bay of New York harbor. This island may be visited by securing a pass from the Commissioner of Immigration.

CATHEDRAL OF ST. JOHN THE DIVINE, located at Amsterdam Avenue, 110th to 113th Streets, is America's greatest church edifice. When completed it will be the largest Gothic Cathedral in the world. The seating capacity is 15,000 and room for 40,000 standing. It has been in the building for the last 61 years the corner stone being laid in 1892. Visitors are always welcome and services are held practically all day.

THE GEORGE WASHINGTON BRIDGE, over the Hudson River, is the longest suspension bridge in the East, connecting New York City at 179th Street and Fort Lee, N. J. It is used by millions of people annually, and is the Northern route to motorists going South from the North. Its towers, which stand 80 feet higher than the Washington Monument can be seen for miles around. The New York tower has the "Will Rogers Memorial Beacon," which serves as a guide to aviators.

THE THEATRICAL DISTRICT OF NEW YORK, where all of the largest and best plays are staged and produced, is located in the heart of the city. Here you will find the largest and best showhouses in the world from 39th to 52nd Streets and 8th to 6th Ave.

The colored show houses are located in Harlem: The Lafayette at 7th and 132nd Street; a W. P. A. house and the Apollo at 125th near 8th Avenue are the largest.

THE GENERAL POST OFFICE is the largest post office in the world. It covers 2 city blocks from 31st Street to 33rd and from 8th to 9th Avenue. It houses 18,000 employees, makes 26 collections and 3 to 4 deliveries a day.

THE HOLLAND TUNNEL is the busiest vehicular tunnel in the world. Starts at Canal Street in New York and ends at 14th Street, Jersey City; N. J. This tunnel contains 2 tubes: one for West bound and the other for East bound traffic; each 2 tubes wide. The toll is 50c per car.

THE TRI-BOROUGH BRIDGE, which connects three of the boroughs of Greater New York (Manhattan, Bronx, Queens). This bridge is 17½ miles long and is the most direct route to the New York World's Fair. The toll charge is 25c.

CHINATOWN, at the Bowery and Chatham Square, is New York's Oriental section. Sight seeing busses will take visitors there from Times Square. Showing the Bloody Corner at Pell and Mott Streets which was the place of countless murders caused by the rivalry of the "Geesay" and "Sag Toigs."

THE HAYDEN PLANETARIUM, which is located in the American Museum of Natural History at 81st Street and Central Park West can be seen "The Drama of the Skies." The most interesting feature of the Planetarium is the "Hall of the Sun," which shows the Solar System. There are six performances daily starting at 11 A. M. except Sunday and holidays. On these days the show starts at 10 A. M. The admission is 25c, 11 to 5 o'clock, 15c, 5 to 8 P. M. Saturday, Sunday and holidays, Children under 17, 10c. Reservations at all times. Reserved seats 50c and 60c.

ROCKEFELLER CENTER largest building erected by private capital. Is situated between 7th and 8th Avenue at 51st Streets, and occupies 12 acres. The tallest building in the city is the Radio City Building and is 70 stories tall and houses the National Broadcasting Company. The West of Rockefeller Center is the Radio City Music Hall, R. K. O. Building, C.T.A. Building west and the Center Theatre, also Radio City which is named in honor of the Radio Corporation of America. On the 5th Avenue side which is toward the Le Maison Francaise, British Empire Building, Italian Building and six story extension of the International Building.

POINTS OF INTEREST IN NEW YORK CITY

CITY HALL at Broadway, Park Row and Chambers Street. It is the seat of government of the great metropolis and can be visited by the public from 10 o'clock A. M. to 4 P. M. daily.

CENTRAL PARK, which is the largest park in the city is located at 5th Avenue and Central Park West, 59th to 110th Streets. It contains 862 acres of which is water. It is 2½ miles long and half a mile wide. It contains a Zoological Park and many play grounds.

THE AQUARIUM, located at the Battery, can be reached by all subway and elevated lines. The exhibit includes all kinds of fish, both salt and fresh water also invertebrates. Open daily: hours 9 to 5 P. M. April to September, and 9 A. M. to 4 P. M. October to March. The admission is free. The New York Aquarium is probably the largest in the world and has the largest collection of fish. It contains 7 large pools and 144 glass fronted aquaria.

COOPER UNION-MUSEUM FOR THE ARTS OF DECORATION, Cooper Square at 7th St., Open daily except Sundays, 10-5., evenings, Oct. 1- 6:30- 9:30 Except Saturdays and Sundays. Free.

CLOISTERS, The Branch of Metropolitan Museum of Art, Fort Tyron Park. Hrs: 10-5., Sundays 1-6., Closed Christmas Morning. Free except Mon. and Fri. 25c. Hrs. 8 to dusk; Sundays and Holidays 10 to dusk; Library closed on Sat., July

NEW YORK ZOOLOGICAL PARK, Bronx Park—Hrs. 10 to dusk every day. Free except Mondays and Thursday Adults 25c, Children 15c.

NEW YORK BOTANICAL GARDEN, East of 200th St., and Webster Avenue. Hrs. March 1 to November 1, 10 to 5; November to March 1, 10 to 4:30.

NEW YORK MUSEUM OF SCIENCE AND INDUSTRY, R. C. A. Bldg., Rockefeller Center. Hrs: 10 to 10 every day. Adult's 25c. Children 10c.

AMERICAN MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY, Central Park West at 79th St. Hrs: 9 to 5; Sunday 1 to 5. Free

AMERICAN GEOGRAPHICAL SOCIETY, Broadway at 156th St. Hrs: 9 to 4:45 Closed Sundays and Holidays; and on Saturdays during the summer.

MUSEUM OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK, Fifth Avenue at 104th St. Hrs: 10-5, Sundays 1-5. Closed Tuesdays. Free except Mondays 25c.

JAMES A. JACKSON

By E. Frederic Morrow

The Standard Oil Company of New Jersey, one of the largest business enterprises in the world, created a sensation back in 1934 when it announced that James A. Jackson had been retained as a special representative to conduct research and promotion work in the Negro market. This forward step by big business was welcomed by the colored public.

James A. Jackson's whole colorful life has found him advancing from one constructive position to another, each with greater potentialities for service than the last.

He started out in life as a waiter, bellboy, dining room employee, and minstrel performer in the early days. He was the first Negro bank clerk in Illinois then employed by Jennings Real Estate and Loan Company, Chicago. This was in 1904.

During the World War he was commissioned Adjutant of the First Provisional Regiment, as the Fifteenth was originally known when it was organized. He was the only one of two Negroes ranking as Agent-In-Charge, U. S. Military Intelligence, during the War.

In 1933, Mr. Jackson resigned as Business Specialist from the U. S. Dept. of Commerce in Washington, D. C. On April 7, 1934 he accepted the position as Special Representative with the Esso Marketeers, the selling organization of Standard Oil Company of New Jersey and its affiliates, which comprises the Standard Oil of Penn., The Standard Oil of Louisiana and the Colonial Beacon Oil Company, Inc.

As special Representative his duties are with the advertising and Trade promotion depts., with some joint services to the Market Research Dept. covering about 25,000 miles a year in the interest of his company. Of the 830 Dealers in the Country 312 are Negroes.

These companies operate in eighteen states, and by arrangement for exchange of courtesy cards, recognition with fourteen other oil companies enables customers to travel over the whole of the United States and Canada on the courtesy cards of their issue to patrons qualifying for credit consideration.

The Standard Oil Company of New Jersey has given every reason for the Negro to look upon the Company and its affiliates with favor.

The company accords courteous service, and members of the race have found employment in positions of consequence and responsibility.

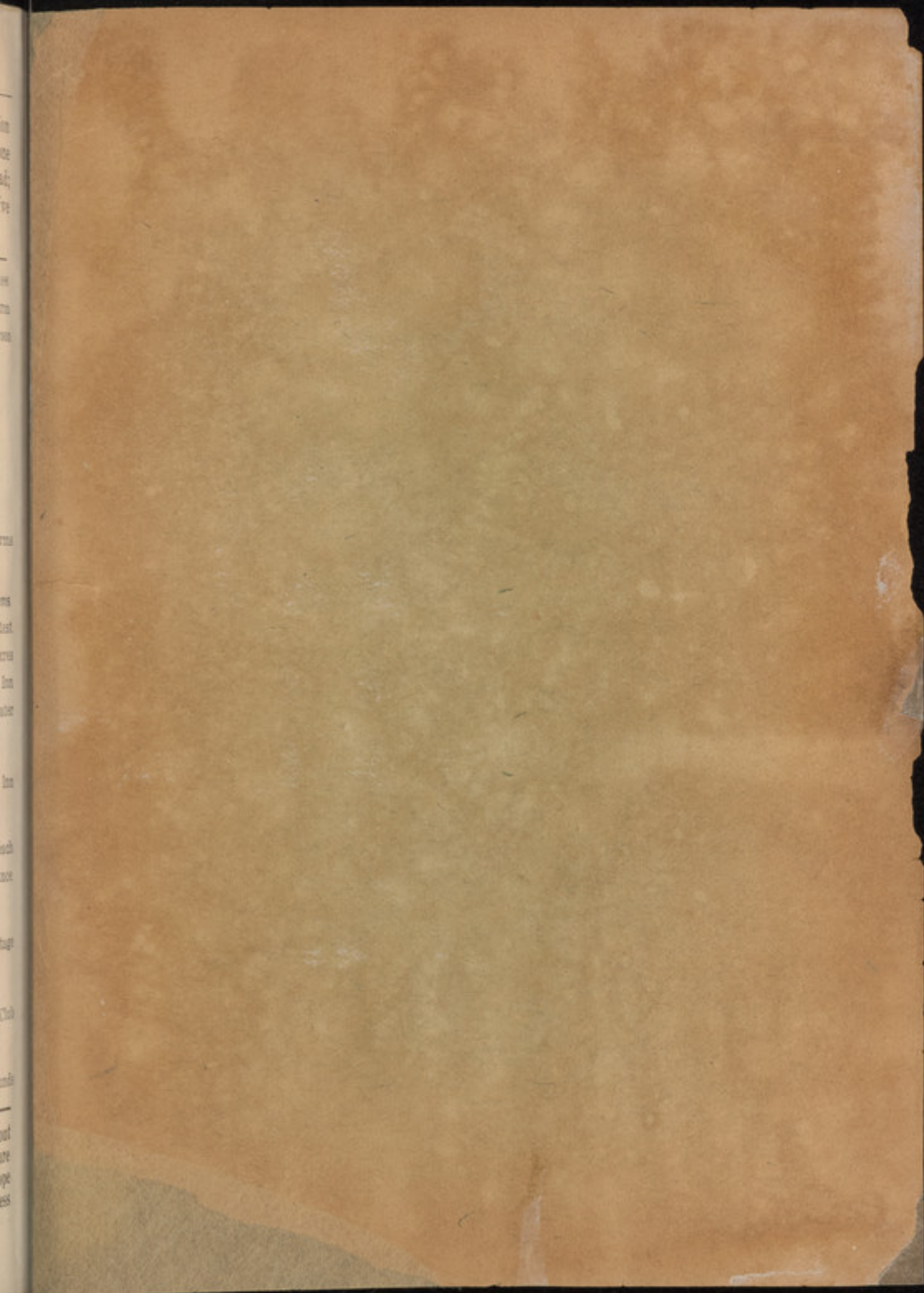
