The following information was furnished to the Liaison Agent, May 23, 1961, by James Hunt, Central Intelligence Agency (U)

During the course of an early interrogation of [Chipmunk] information was developed indicating that a woman married to a Swedish diplomat had been recruited in Europe in 1950 by the KGB. Subsequent investigation has disclosed that the woman is Marie Louise Wanda Hagberg, who is married to Bill Rune Bengt Hagberg, presently serving as Swedish Consul in Havana, Cuba. He has been in that position since March 1960. Subject was born February 19, 1931, in France. (S)

Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) recently developed information indicating that subject traveled to Miami, Florida, on or about January 16, 1961, and stopped at the Columbia Hotel. She returned to Havana on January 19, 1961. Hunt stated that a communication is being prepared for the Bureau setting forth all pertinent details. He said that any information which we might be able to develop through contacts at the Columbia Hotel in Miami, might prove to be of significant interest. (U)

With regard to the reliability of the information, Hunt stated that [Chipmunk] became aware of this woman a few years ago and had direct access to information which left little doubt that she had been working for KGB. (S)

### ACTION:

The above information is being directed to the attention of the espionage section. Liaison will follow to obtain report from CIA. (U)
