The unexecuted Articles of Incorporation of the Free Voice of Latin America, Inc., as furnished by NO T-1 are quoted below:

"ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION : UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
Of : STATE OF LOUISIANA
FREE VOICE OF LATIN AMERICA, INC. : PARISH OF ORLEANS

"BE IT KNOWN, That on this day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty, and of the independence of the United States of America the one hundred and eighty-fifth:

"BEFORE ME, HARRY R. CABRAL, JR., a Notary Public, duly commissioned and qualified in and for the Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana, therein residing, and in the presence of the witnesses hereinafter named and undersigned;

"PERSONALLY CAME AND APPEARED the several persons whose names are hereunto subscribed, all of the full age, who severally declared that availing themselves of the benefits and provisions of the constitution of the State of Louisiana and the laws of the said State relative to the organization of non-profit corporations, and particularly the provisions of R. S. 12:101-155 inclusive, they have united to form, and do by these presents form and organize themselves, as well as all other persons who may hereafter join or become associated with them or their successors, into a non-profit corporation for the objects and purposes and under the covenants, stipulations and agreements following, to-wit:
