

Remarks: As to the item "8" (Number of cases unemployment insurance disconting in April 1950), trying to get information of Kanazawa city and Wajima, figures of which will be informed later.

The medical care practices and facilities under Social Insurance of Ishikawa pref were reviewed.

Naruwa Hospital owned by Welfare Ministry and operated by Social Insurance Association, and has been utilized to full capacity by the patients under Government and Association managed Health Insurance and Governmental mutual Aid Association. This hospital was pyrchased by Welfare Ministry on August 1946 for the Social Insurance patients, specially for Health Insurance patients. To meet their increasing demands, this hospital has been very anxious to enlarge its scale. Its doctors made complaints about the limits of medical care under Social Insurance system. \*

Ishikawa Gun Chuo Hospital (owned and operated by Ishikawa Gun National Health Insurance society Federation, covering 71,270 (14,567 Househods) of 83,866 (16,206 Households) of 32 towns and villages) has been utilized 60% by National Health Insurance patients, 25% by Health Insurance patients, 8% by Mutual Aid Association patients, 7% by Private patients and less than 1% by Public Assistance patients. Of its 32 societies, 22 societies under operation and 10 societies under suspension of operation. Then, the Pref Insurance sect had the conference with the interested officials of the 10 societies under suspension at Match Town, Ishikawa Gun, to which the author was invited. Most of their reasons were their financial delinquencies and the differential treatments of the Insurance Drs. After the conference, Nakaoku village, Tomioku village, Yuwakutani village were found to have the intention to reoperate.
