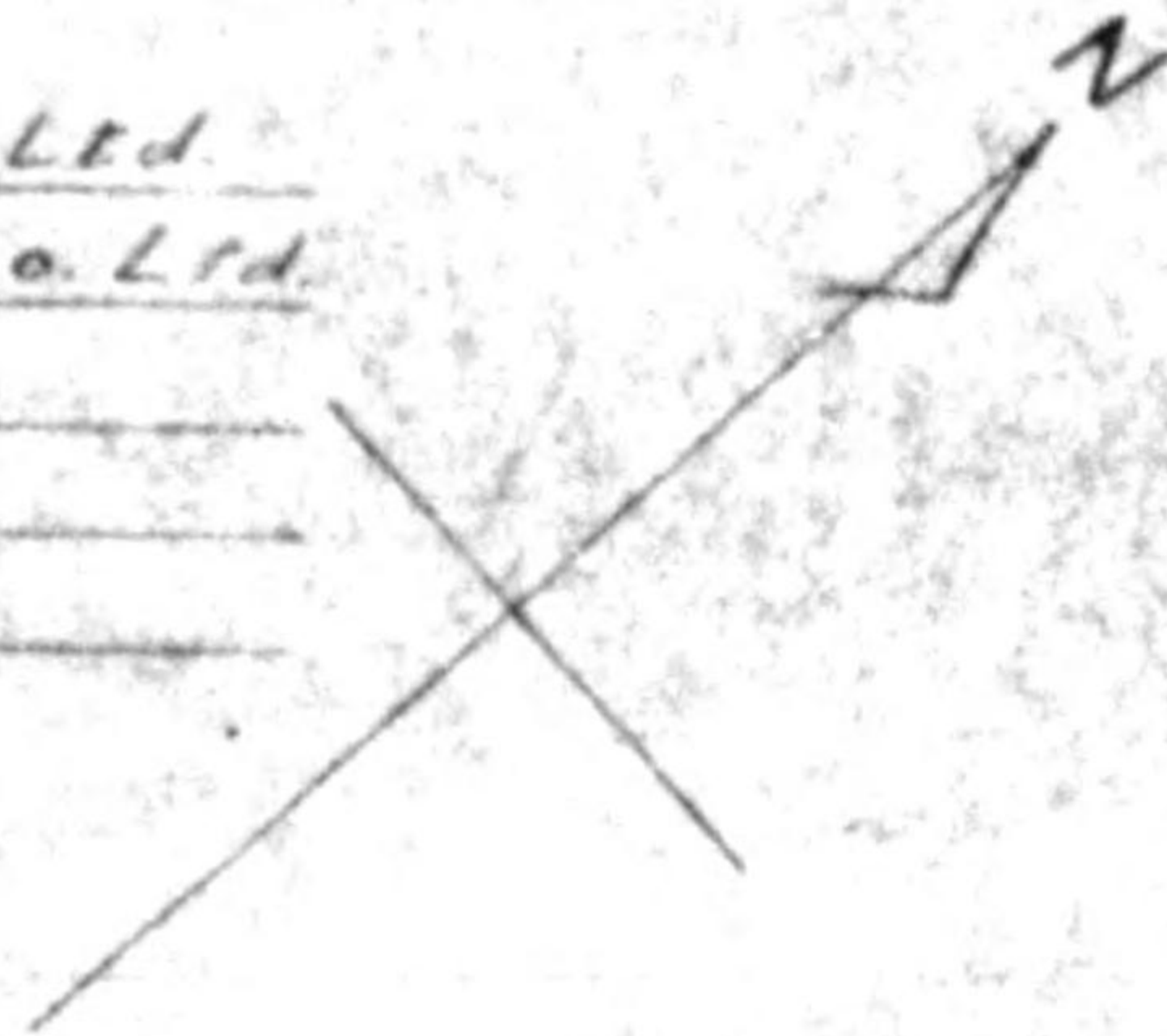

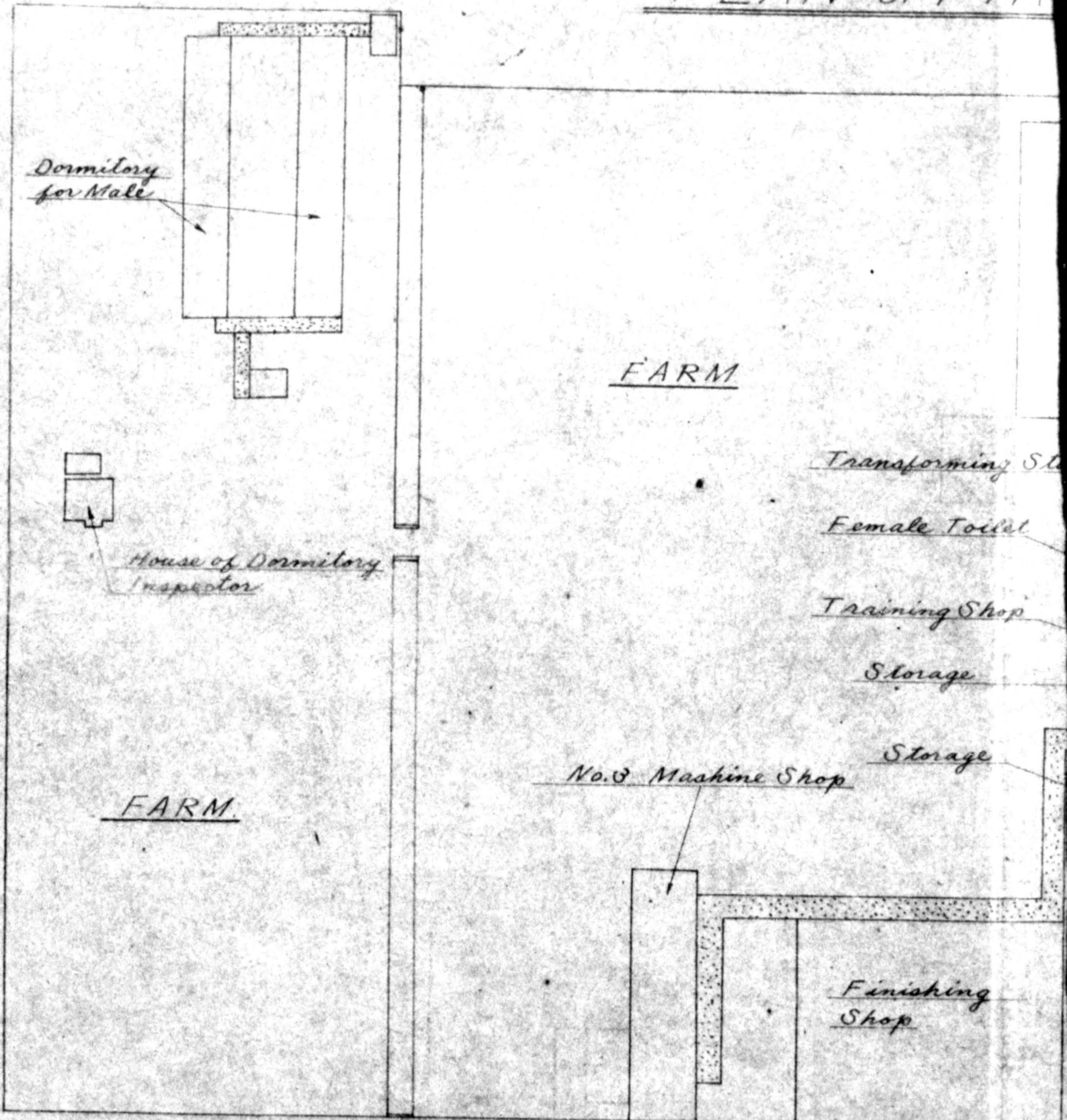

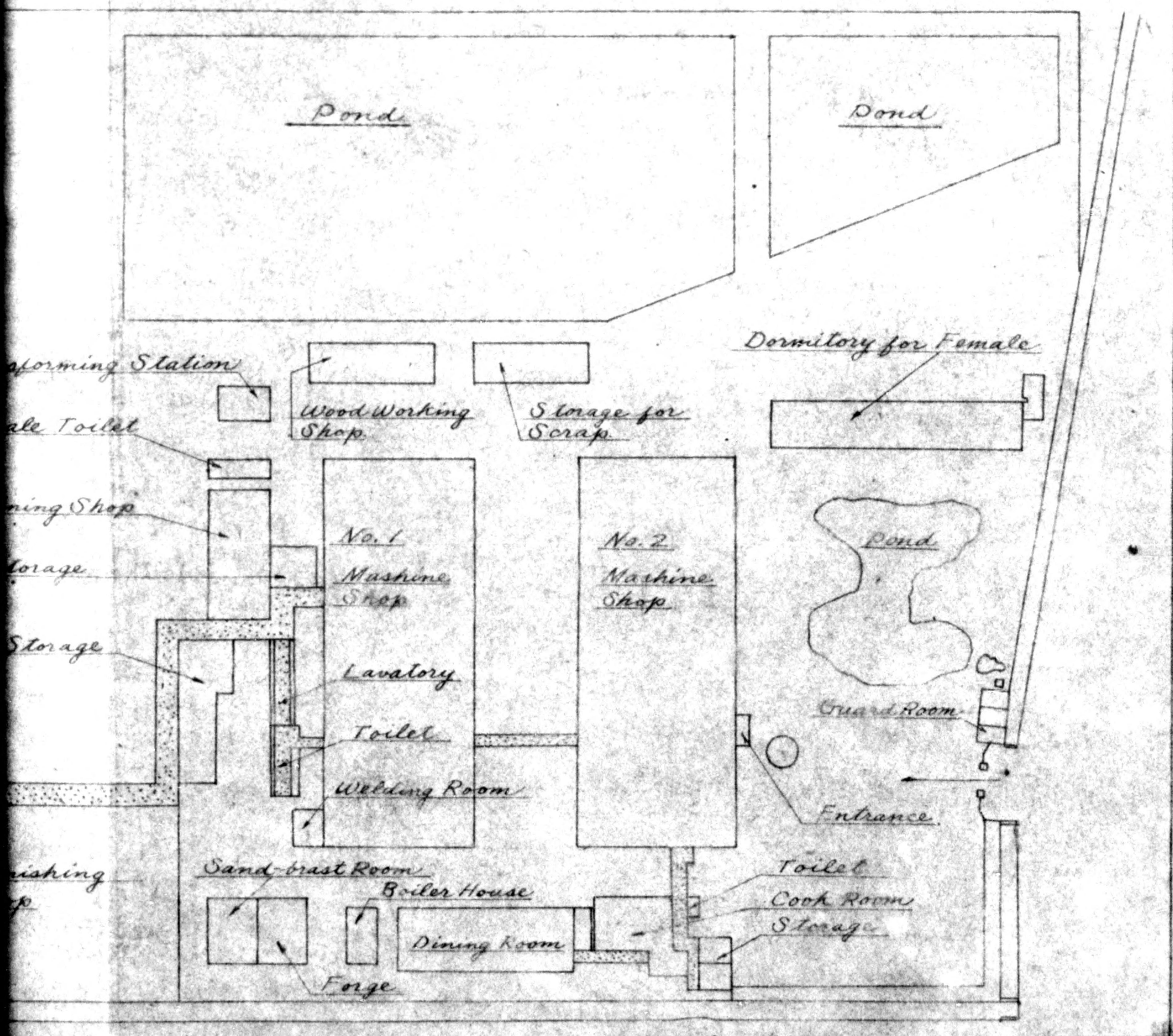
PLAN of FIRM

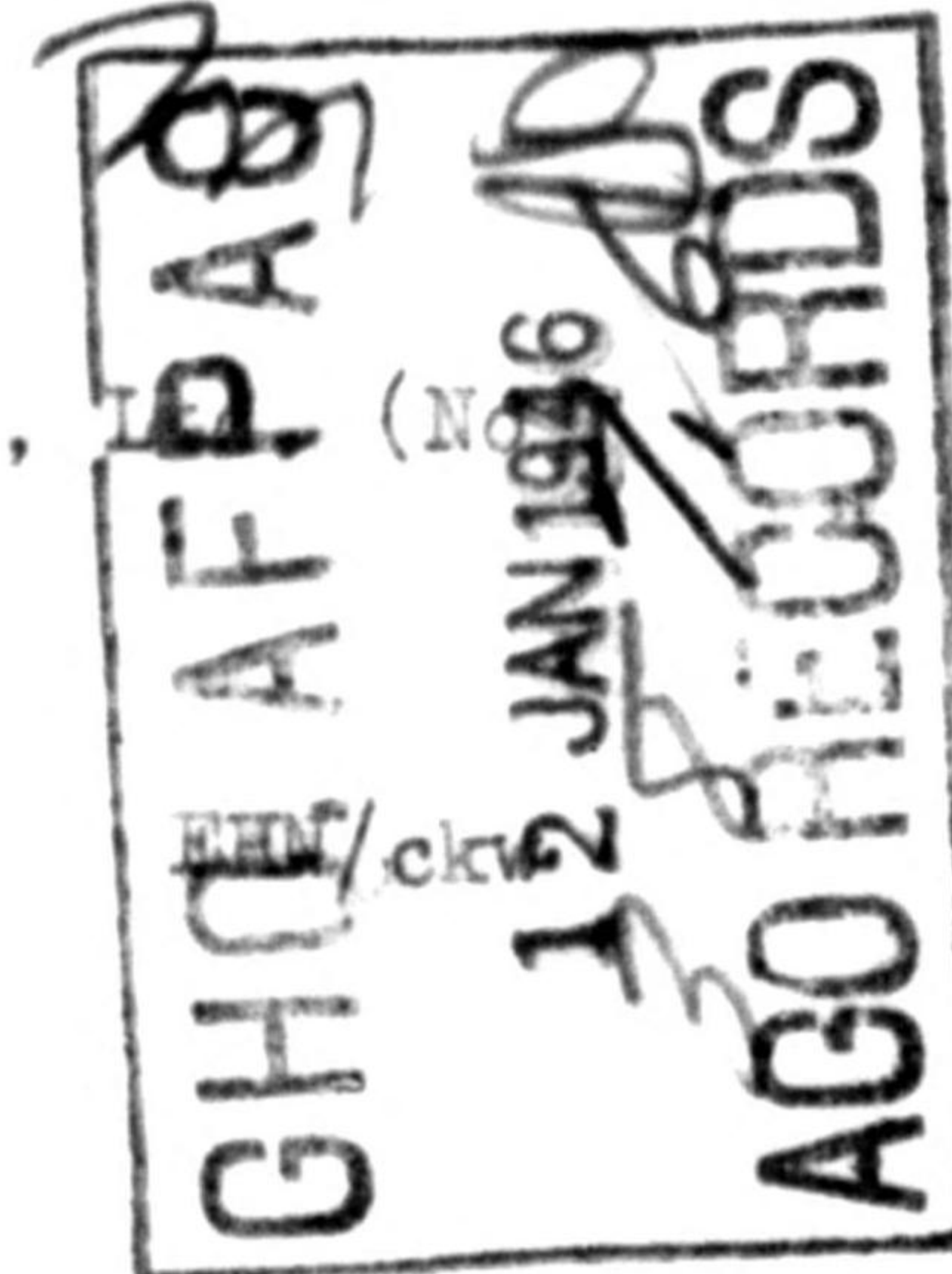

Although production of machine tools continued throughout the war, the total value of this equipment was of minor significance, compared to the value of the arms which the plant produced. For all purposes, the Asada Seiko Co. can be considered as constructed for production of munitions.

4. The application of the Asada Seiko Co. is based primarily on the importance of the work which the company is now in a position to perform. There is admittedly a need for the fish-net weaving machines which the company is manufacturing. However, it is believed that the manufacture of these machines can be accomplished equally as well by plants which are not subject to reparations.

5. It is the recommendation of this headquarters that the application of the Asada Seiko Co. for removal from the reparations list be denied. ✓

2. In 2nd indorsement to reference letter, paragraph 1, above, this headquarters concurred in the recommendation that the Asada Seiko & Co. be included on the list of plants subject to reparations. Favorable action was taken by your headquarters on this request, and the plant was listed on inclosure 4 of SCAPIN 1376, dated 5 December 1946, as a reparation selection within the munitions industry.

3. It is the opinion of this headquarters that the Asada Seiko Co. is properly listed as a reparations plant. The plant was constructed in 1939, and was intended for the manufacture of machine tools. Production was scarcely underway in this plant, when in 1940 it was directed to undertake the manufacture of small parts of torpedoes, and similar munitions. This production continued throughout the balance of the war, and the vast portion of the commodities produced by this plant, consisted of munitions. Although production of machine tools continued throughout the war, the total value of this equipment was of minor significance, compared to the value of the arms which the plant produced. For all purposes, the Asada Seiko Co. can be considered as constructed for production of munitions.

4. The application of the Asada Seiko Co. is based primarily on the importance of the work which the company is now in a position to perform. There is admittedly a need for the fish-net weaving machines which the company is manufacturing. However, it is believed that the manufacture of these machines can be accomplished equally as well by plants which are not subject to reparations.

5. It is the recommendation of this headquarters that the application of the Asada Seiko Co. for removal from the reparations list be denied.
