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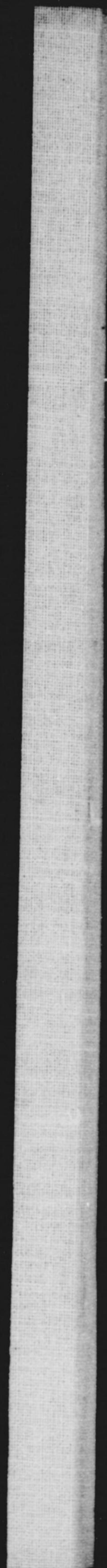

ウィリアム・ペチーは一六二三年倫敦近郊に生れ、幼時より數學を好み、十五歳の時ノルマン・ジールに渡つて佛語、數學を學んだ。一六四四年ライデン大學に醫學を研究し、その間巴里にてホッブスと識りその影響を受けた。當時一般論者は曖昧な計算のみによつて議論を立てゝ居た、従つて正確な報告の蒐集は最も必要とせられたところで、彼は土地及び其產物、並びに貨幣、勞銀及び人口の徹底的調査に努力した。彼は實に英國に於ける統計學の母たると共に、併せて經濟學成立史上に於て重要な役割を演じた「政治算術」の名附親である。

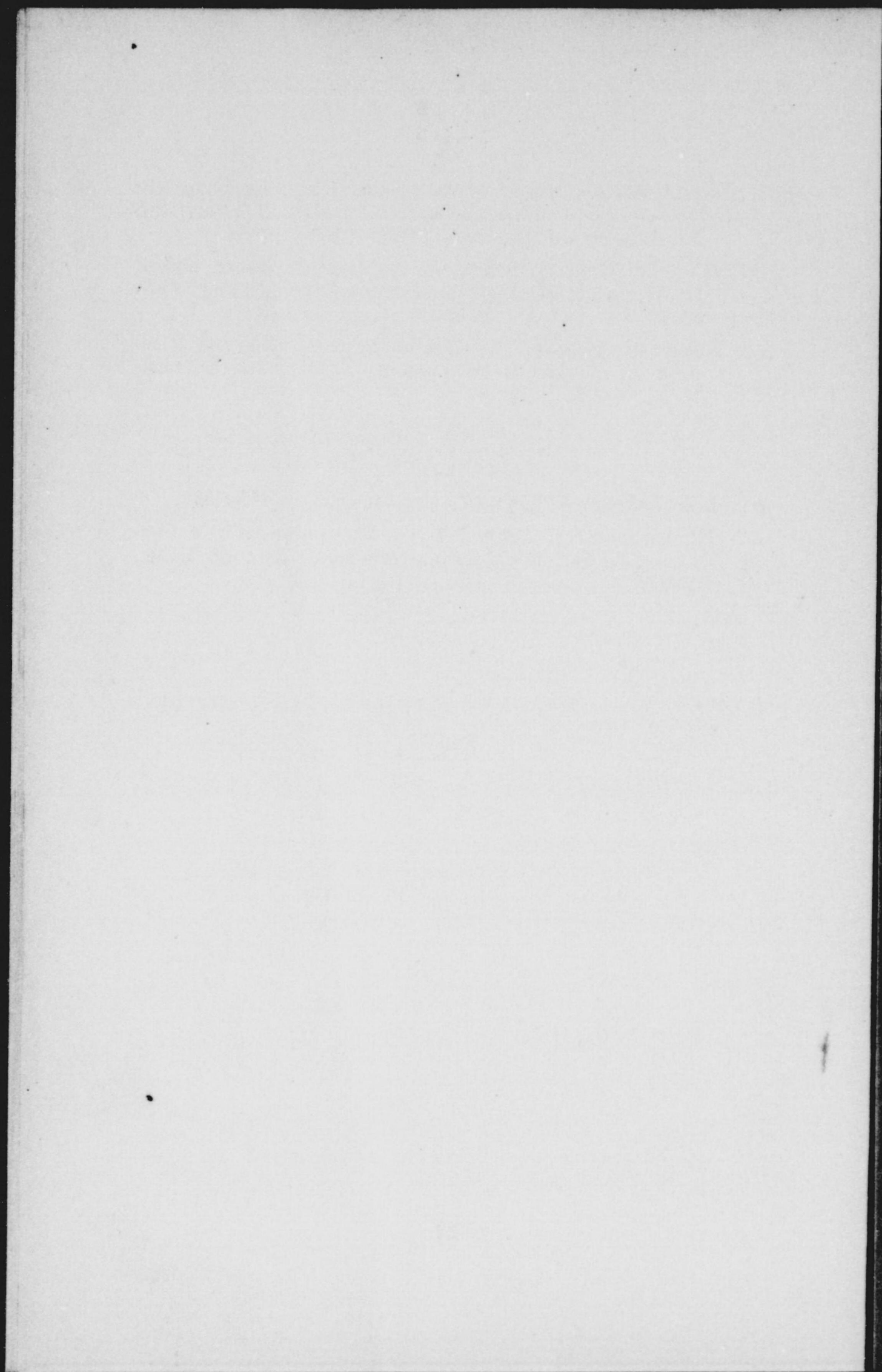
