Welcome to Istanbul!

Istanbul, the largest city in Türkiye and the thirteenth-largest city in the world by population, is located on two sides of the Bosphorus Strait, a 31-km-long waterway that separates Asia from Europe.

Wikidata İstanbul Conference 2022 will be held in the Asian (Anatolian) part of the city at the entrance of the Bosphorus. The venue of the event, Üsküdar University, takes its name from the Üsküdar district it is situated in. Üsküdar is a major transport hub, with ferries and rail service (Marmaray) to the European side where the historical peninsula; and home to about half a million people, numerous historic buildings and Maiden's Tower, one of the symbols of İstanbul from Byzantine times. How to Get Around Public Transport in Istanbul

İstanbulkart is the prepaid public transportation card for Istanbul and it is the cheapest and the most efficient way to get around Istanbul. You can purchase İstanbulkart via yellow/blue vending machines (**biletmatik**) and via and via kiosks located by the majority of the public buses' stops.

When you ride a bus, metro, ferry, funicular or tramway, you can pay for your fare by 'waving' your İstanbulkart within 8 cm of the reader. Upon making a successful payment, the reader will make a sound and the screen will light up showing the amount left on the card.

Fees

To obtain İstanbulkart you need to pay a non-refundable fee of **₺50**. The cost of 1-ride public transportation is **₺7,67**.

Alternatively you can choose from **1, 2, 3, 5, 7 or 10-Day-Pass** or **İstanbul City Card (for tourists)** options.

Way 1

Take the **M4 (Sabiha Gökçen Havalimanı metro station)**

- Kurtköy
- Yayalar - Şeyhli
- Fevzi Çakmak - Hastane

Depart at **Tavşantepe**

Transfer **M4 (to Kadıköy route)**

- 18 stations

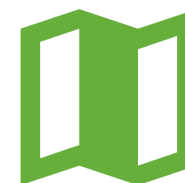
Depart at **Kadıköy**

Way 2

Take the  **13** (direction: Batı Ataşehir Peronlar)

Depart at **Şehit Erol Olçok**

Walk to Mercure İstanbul Altunizade (The route is below)

From the Istanbul Airport (IST) to hotel (Mercure Altunizade)

Walk to VIP Terminal - Mülki İdare - Emniyet Bus Stop
(The route is on the side)

Take the  H-2

Depart at **Çağlayan**

Walk to Çağlayan Metrobus Stop (The route is on the side)

Take the  **Söğütlüçeşme** (*direction: Söğütlüçeşme*)

Depart at **Altunizade**

Walk to Mercure İstanbul Altunizade (The route is on the side)

Life in Istanbul

Money

The official currency of Türkiye is Turkish Lira (TRY, ₺); Please note that you will need to use TRY for your spending. It's possible to easily change money in exchange offices and banks everywhere in Türkiye.

Credit and debit cards are widely used in the country. Visa and MasterCard are accepted in a wide range of locations.

Electricity access

Türkiye operates on 230V supply voltage and 50Hz. Sockets are type F (also known as Schuko). This socket also works with plug C and plug E. Please bring your adapter if needed!

Rules of Hygiene

In order to protect all participants, service partners, and also our own staff from infection with SARS-CoV-2 as well as monkeypox, the following rules and measures apply to the Wikidata Summit and all side events.

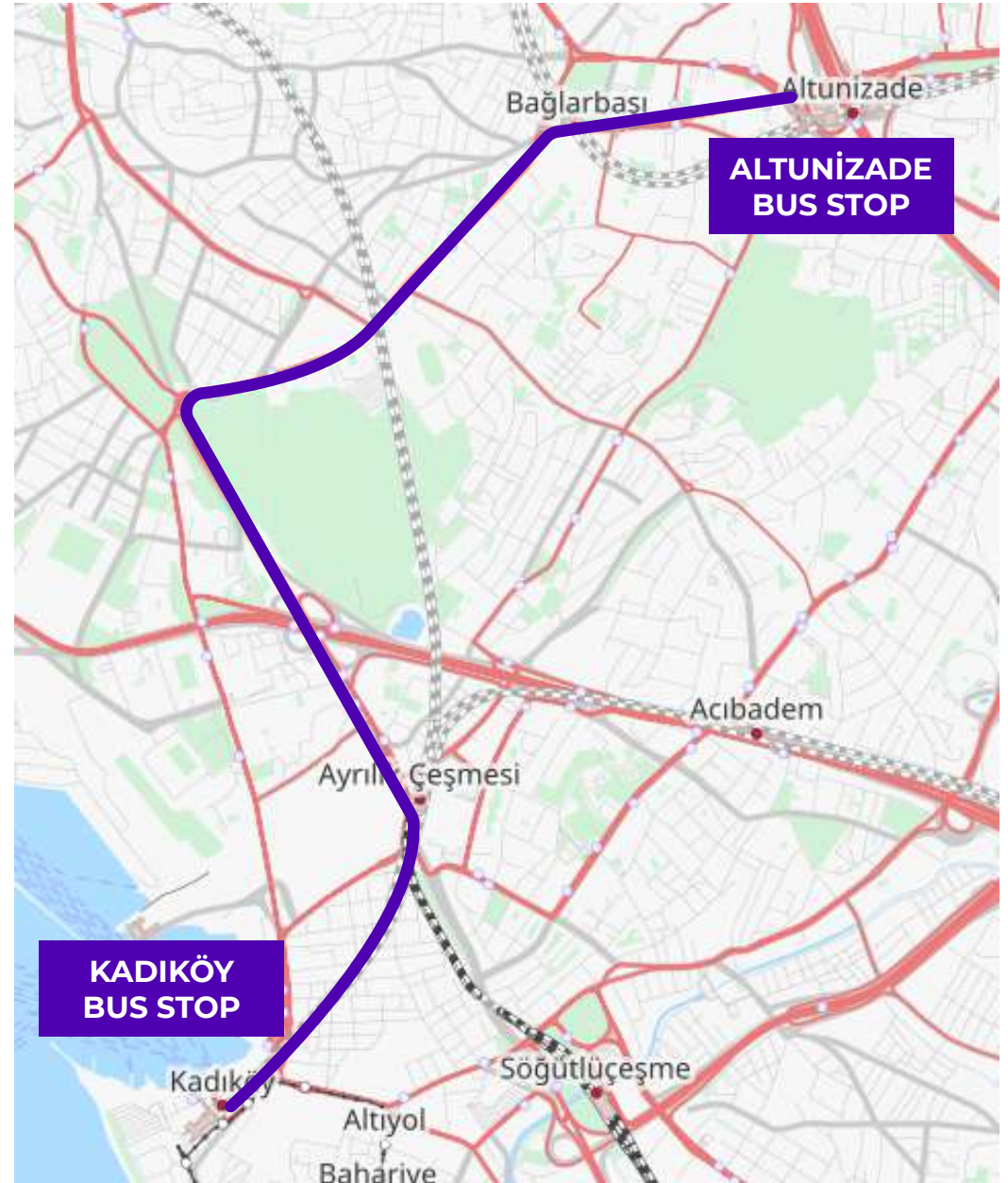

Map for Kadıköy Bus Station to Altunizade Bus Station (13)

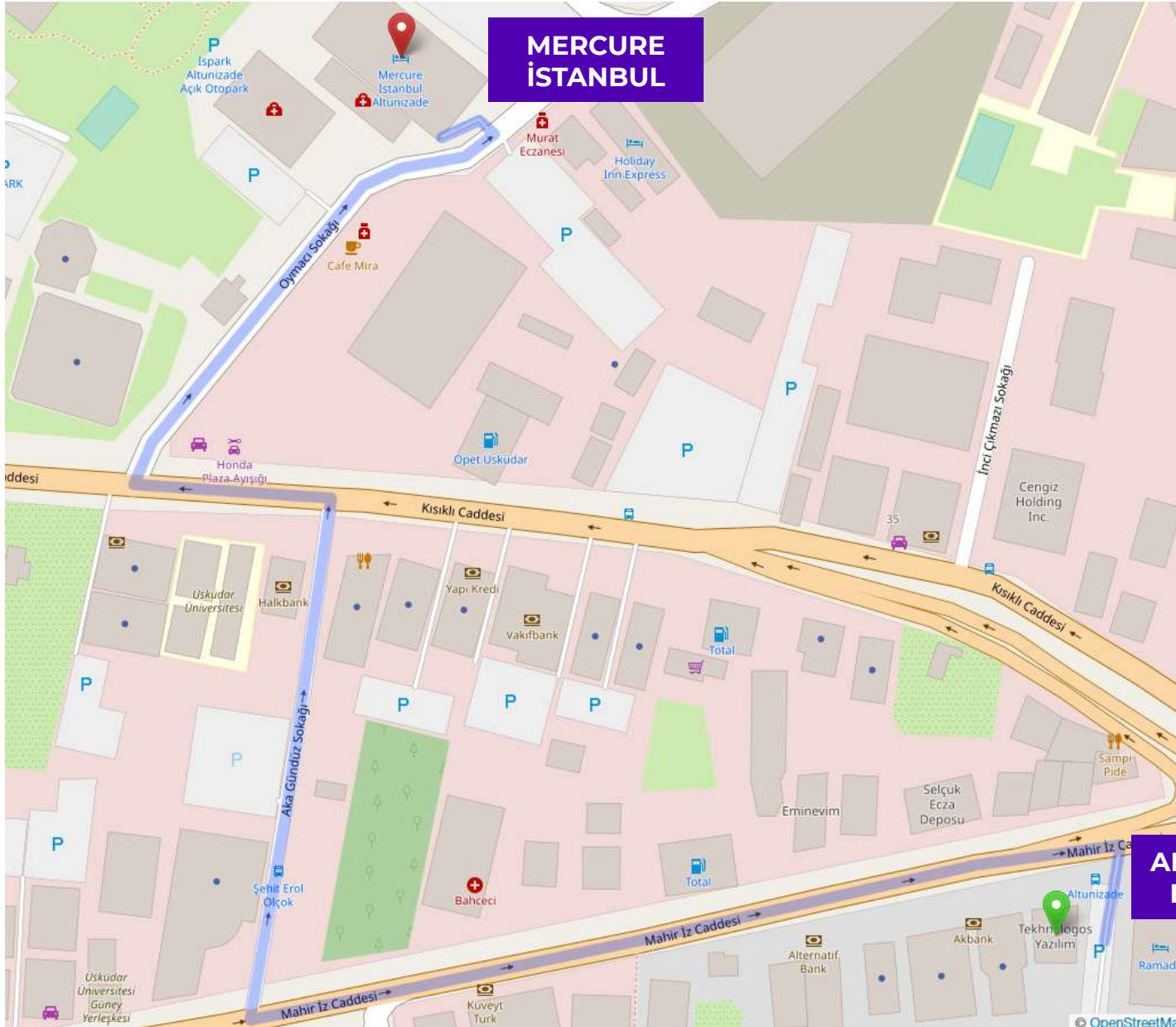
When you get on the bus, check the visual information screens in the vehicle and the names of the stops where the bus stops.
