Offered 15 February 2022 – 30 January 2024 (16:00 UTC)



29 countries (25 EU Member States and 4 UCPM¹ Participating States) providing energy supplies



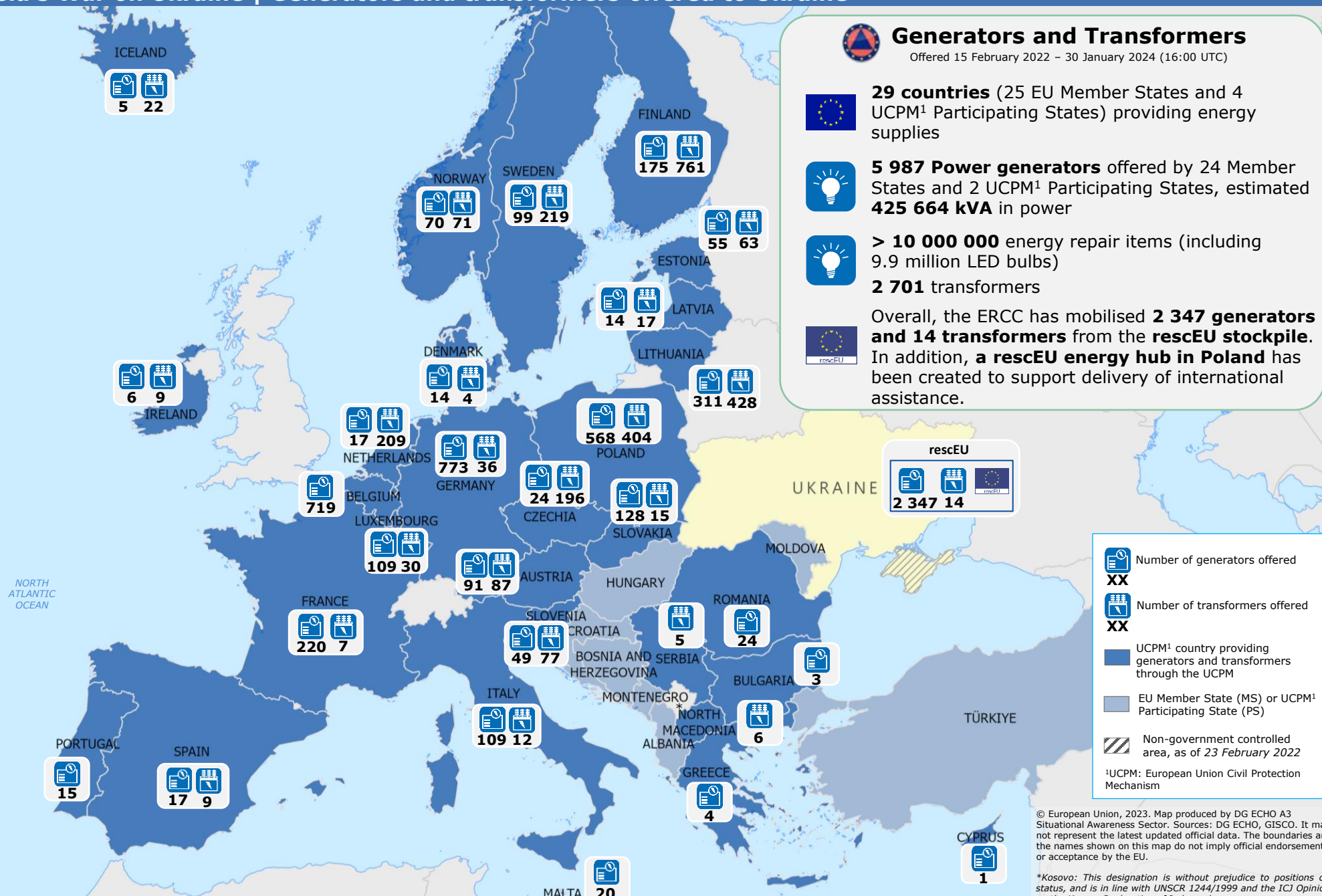
5 987 Power generators offered by 24 Member States and 2 UCPM¹ Participating States, estimated **425 664 kVA** in power



> 10 000 000 energy repair items (including 9.9 million LED bulbs)
2 701 transformers



Overall, the ERCC has mobilised **2 347 generators and 14 transformers** from the **rescEU stockpile**. In addition, a **rescEU energy hub in Poland** has been created to support delivery of international assistance.
