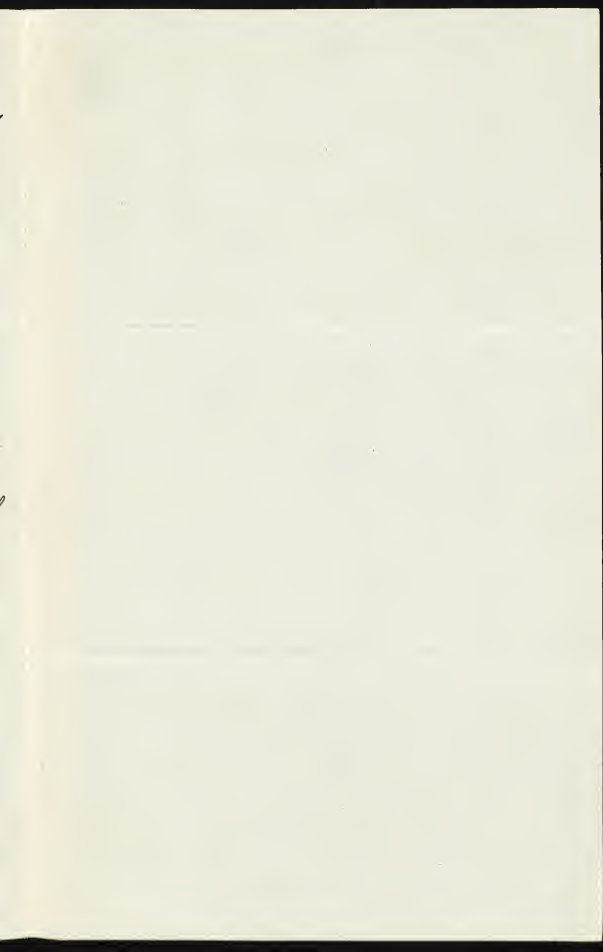
Mr. May
