MEMORANDUM FOR: IMPERIAL JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

THROUGH: Central Liaison Office, Tokyo

SUBJECT: Repatriation from Japan to Former Mandated  
Islands

1. Reference is made to C.L.O. No. 1342(RF), dated  
1 March 1947, subject: Repatriation to Saipan and Palau.

2. Future repatriation from Japan to the islands  
formerly under Japanese mandate will be governed by policies  
stated below:

a. No Japanese or other non-Micronesian persons  
will be permitted to enter those islands pending determina-  
tion of the final status of the islands.


b. Those Micronesian natives and half-breed  
children who elected to accompany Japanese spouse or parent  
on previous repatriation from the former mandated islands to  
Japan may not be repatriated to those islands unless the  
Japanese spouse or parent is deceased or divorced. Such  
death or divorce must be legally established by death certi-  
ficate or divorce decree.

3. The Imperial Japanese Government will:

a. Re-investigate the eligibility of those persons  
named in above listed reference.

b. Submit a corrected list of those still eligible  
for repatriation.
