## AFFIDAVIT

General TADA, Hayao, Japanese army, deposes and states

I was a general in the Japanese Army Lugust 1937 through December 1938 and my assignment was Vice Chief of the General Staff at Tokyo.

As such, I made the plans for the campaign of Jaranese armed forces culminating in the capture of Shanghai 12 November, 1937, the campaign ending in the campaign of heading 13 December, 1937, and the campaign which finally resulted in the taking of Hankow 27 October 1933.

The plans for the capture of Shanghai were made when the incident broke out in Shanghai; during the battle of Shanghai, plans were drawn up for the capture of Nanking, and plans for the capture of Hankow were drawn up in June or July 1938.
