



Storia [modifica]

Presa coscienza dell'enorme divario di genere durante le presentazioni (sopratutto da parte di Rosiestep e FloNight) a Wikimania Esino Lario 2016, nasce l'idea di fare qualcosa. Dopo la creazione del progetto WikiDonne (4 agosto) per la partecipazione all'editathon HerStory organizzato da May Hachem insieme all'ONU (12 agosto), il 14 ottobre 2016 Camelia inizia le pratiche per il riconoscimento come user group affiliato a Wikimedia Foundation da parte di AffCom. Il gruppo, con sede a Roma, ha la seguente descrizione:

Siamo un gruppo di utenti che hanno lo scopo di aumentare la diversità e migliorare la copertura di argomenti che riguardano le donne in Wikipedia, stilando liste di voci (da creare ex novo, da migliorare e da tradurre) e organizzando eventi. Gli uomini sono i benvenuti sempre, la nostra intenzione non è quella di trasformare Wikipedia in "Donnepedia" ma sensibilizzare tutti sulla realtà del gender gap nei contenuti e partecipazione.

What not to enter:

- Vandalism

- Promotional or celebratory pages
- Biographies structured as cy
- Advertising
- Non-encyclopedic information






What does this mean:

- Freely usable and redistributable content
- Open to everyone's
- Completely free and ad-free
- Try to be independent of ideological types of any kind

- Trying to use free software and open formats as much as possible
 - The editorial line is not imposed from the outside or from above, but entrusted to the user community (minus the 5 pillars)
- Collective work, the articles do not belong to anyone



What does this mean:

- Assume good faith
- Never go back a page more than
 3 times in 24 hours
- Don't fuel change wars
- Don't be rude
- Sign and date your posts in discussions

- Work towards agreement
- Don't ignore the questions
- Be ready to apologize and accept
 an apology
- Helps mediate disagreements between other people





What does this mean:

- Wikipedia has no fixed rules except the five pillars
- The pillars are the only binding and unchangeable principles
- Recommendations and guidelines, general and specific developed by the community with the mechanism of consent

- However, none are fixed
- They can be changed or abolished through discussion
 - Use the common sense

How to registrate on Wikipedia and create the user page



a) Registration. To participate in our edit-a-thons is important that the new users create their wiki account. The wiki account is universal, so you can use it to log in any Wikimedia project: all linguistic versions of Wikipedia (as Wikipedia is based on language, non on countries), Wikimedia Commons, Wikidata, etc. The registration works like any other registration on the web: i) just click on the creation/registration link, ii) choose a valid username and password, iii) add your email (you need to confirm it and recover the account in case you lose the password), iv) pick the CAPTCHA security code you can see on the image, and then v) confirm your account by clicking on the link present on the email you will receive.



b) Login. Once you have confirmed your account, you can log in to the site with the credentials you chose during the registration phase.


