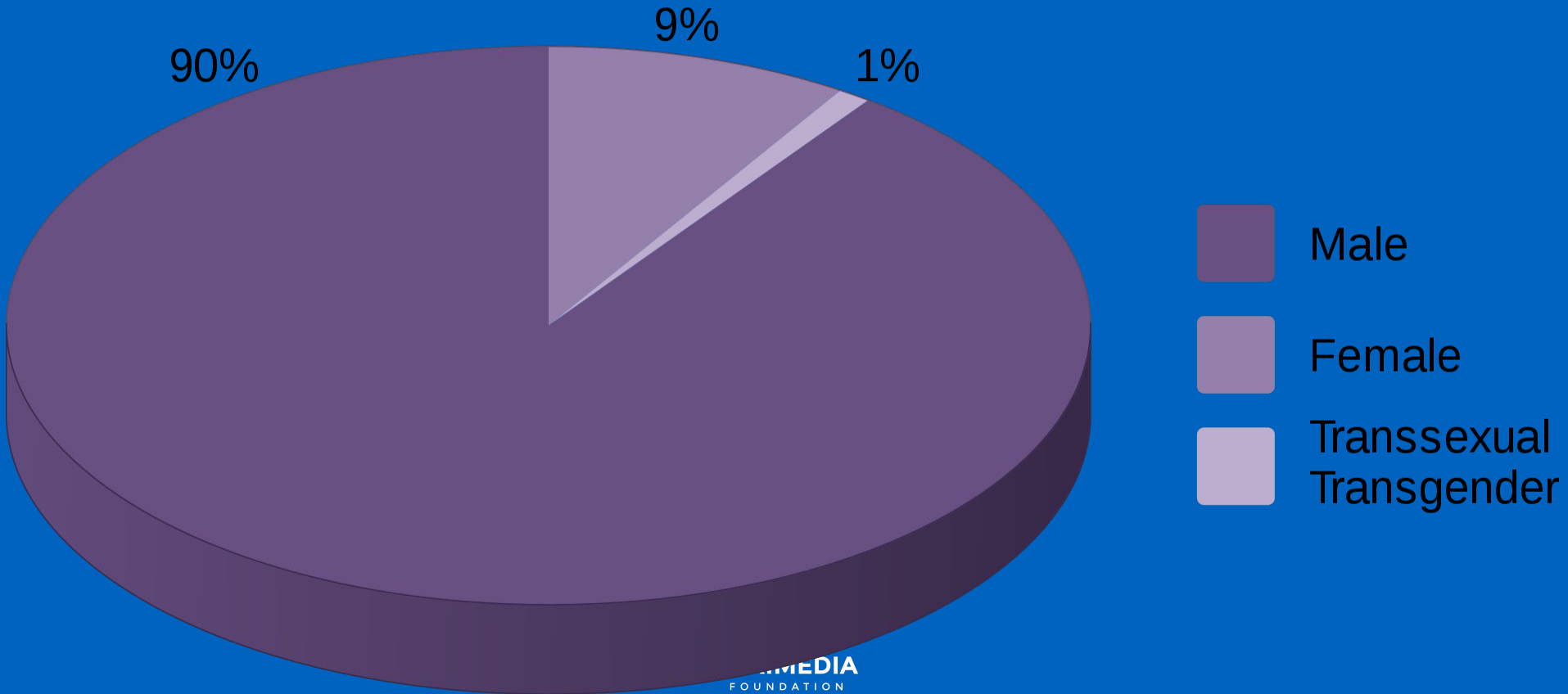

Humaniki provides statistics about the gender gap in the content of all Wikimedia projects

For example, as of Jan 2022, only 18.226% of content in all Wikimedia projects including biographies on Wikipedia are about women.

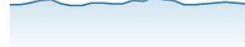

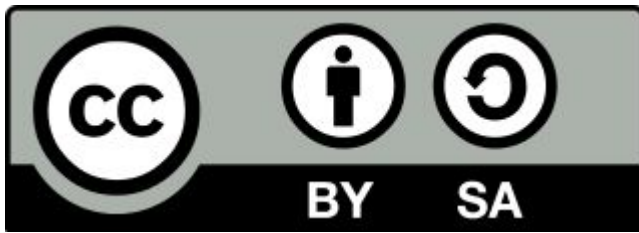
