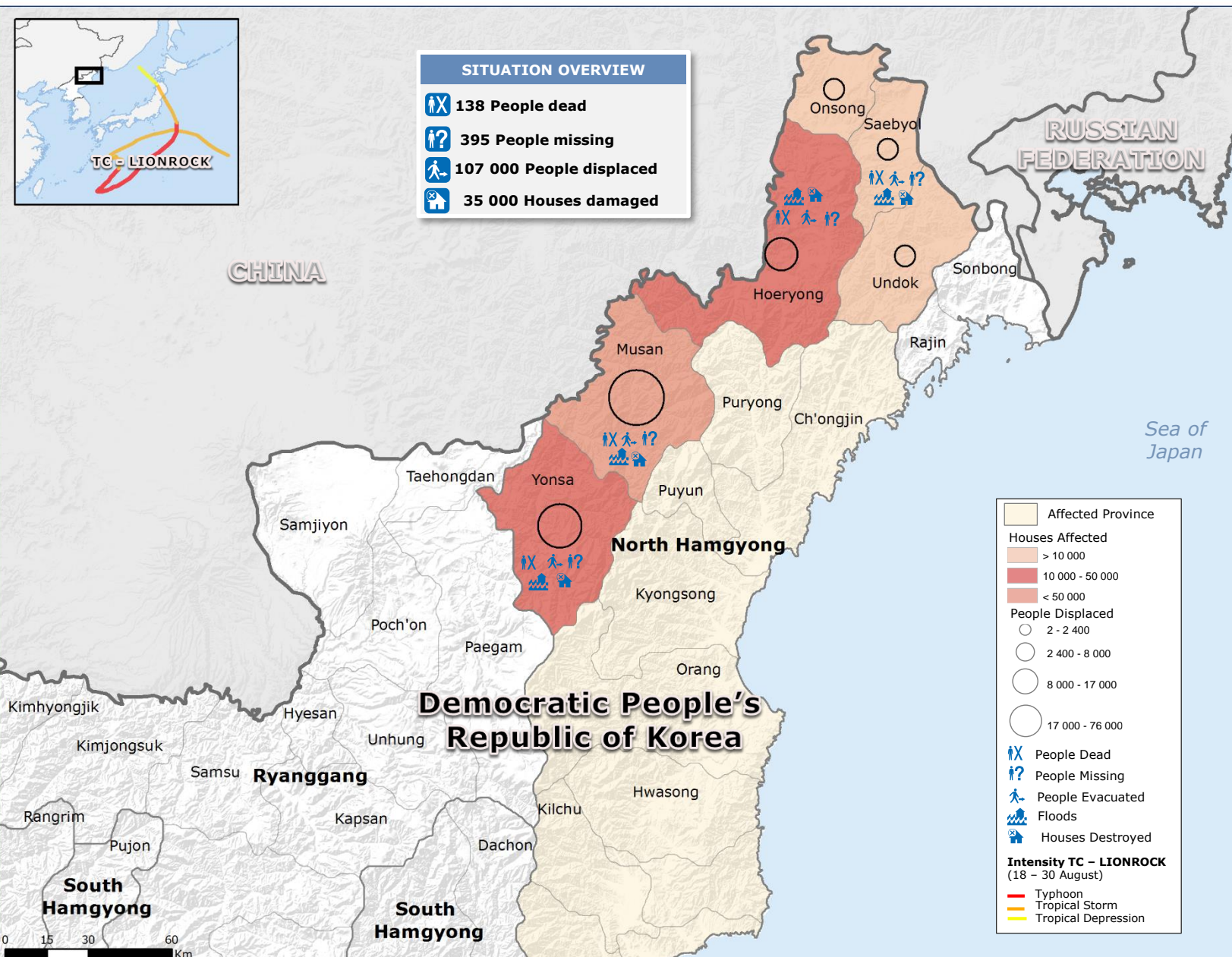

**SITUATION**

- Typhoon LIONROCK and a low pressure system have triggered heavy rains from 28 August to 2 September over the north-western DPRK causing extensive flooding in particular in the North Hamgyong province.
  - At least 138 people have been killed, 395 missing, over 107 000 people have been displaced and more than 35 000 houses have been destroyed. Access and communication to the affected areas is badly impacted.
  - A joint assessment team comprising the Government, UN and other agencies is deploying to the affected areas. Immediate needs have been identified as emergency shelter, food, medication, water and sanitary items.
