
Emergency Response Coordination Centre (ERCC) – ECHO Daily Map | 14/09/2016 Democratic People's Republic of Korea – Severe Weather

SITUATION

- Typhoon LIONROCK and a low pressure system have triggered heavy rains from 28 August to 2 September over the north-western DPRK causing extensive flooding in particular in the North Hamyong province.
- At least 138 people have been killed, 395 missing, over 107 000 people have been displaced and more than 35 000 houses have been destroyed. Access and communication to the affected areas is badly impacted.
- A joint assessment team comprising Government, UN and other agencies is deploying to affected areas. Immediate needs have identified been as emergency shelter, food, medication, water and sanitary items.
