Should the weather prove stormy, we shall defer the visit till some time next week.

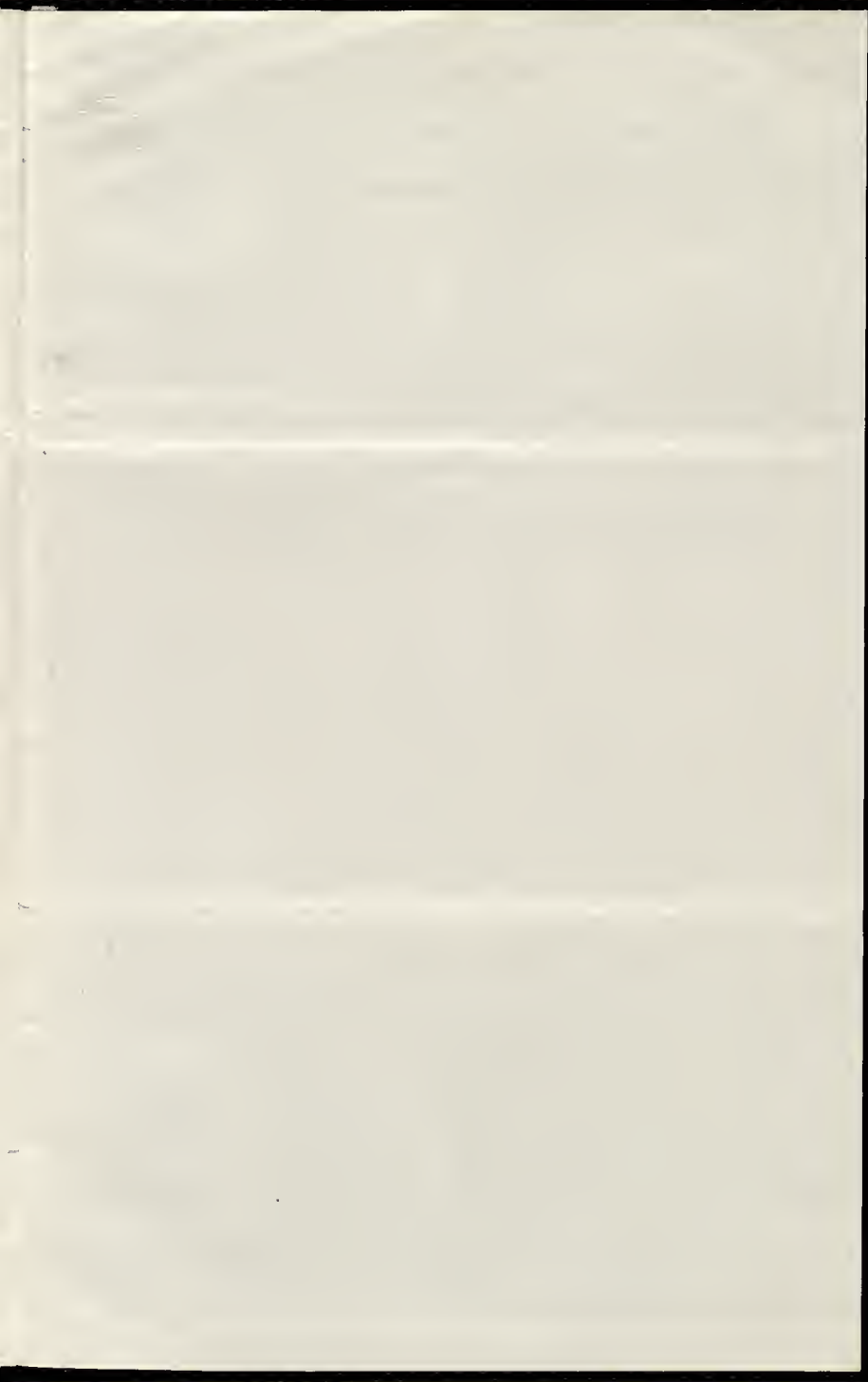
