On 9 January 1946 the records of the Personnel Section, Cabinet Secretariat were examined at the Diet Building, Tokyo.

Complete personnel records of the subject were micro-filmed. Photostatic copies, together with translation, are on file as Exhibit No. 94.

Following is a transcript of the translation:

1902 Jan 23 Appointed 2nd Lt., Artillery (Cabinet)

1902 Nov 7 Awarded 8th Court Rank, Senior Grade

1904 Aug 2 Promoted to 1st Lt., Artillery

1904 Oct 24 Awarded 7th Court Rank, Junior Grade

1905 Jan 20 Was relieved from principal duty and attached to the students' troops of the Military Academy

1905 Dec 16 Relieved from main duty and attached to the Imperial Guard Field Artillery Regiment

1906 Jun 20 Relieved from main duty and attached to the Imperial Guard Field Artillery Regiment

1905 Apr 1 Decorated with the Order of the Golden Kite, 5th Class;
Granted the War medal of Russo-Japanese war;
Was decorated with 6th Order of Merit with Single Ray

1914 Apr 30 Raised to 6th Court Rank, Junior Grade

1914 Aug 10 Relieved as Commissioner of the Inspector General of Military
Training (War Department)

Relieved from main duty and appointed member of the Inspector
of Field Artillery (War Department)

1915 Apr 20 Made an officer de l'ordre de l'etoile noire of the French
Government

1915 Oct 28 Was given charge of the task of the Commissioner of the
Coronation and ordered to work in the Ceremony Section

1906 Jan 21 The Organization of the Commissioner of the Coronation was
abolished

1916 Jun 27 Promoted to Major, Artillery (Cabinet)

1916 Jun 15 Received and allowed to wear the Order of the Belgian Crown

1915 Nov 7 Granted a sum of ¥150.00

1916 Aug 12 Attached to troops dispatched to France (War Department)

1915 Nov 11 Granted the Coronation Memorial Medal

1917 Aug 6 Relieved of main duty and attached to the Inspector General
of Military Training

1917 Dec 24 Raised to 4th Order of the Sacred Treasure

1919 Apr 4 Made an "Officier de l'ordre national de la Legion d'honneur" of France;
Decorated with the Croix de Guerre avec Palme"

1917 Jul 10 Raised to 6th Court Rank, Senior Grade

1919 Aug 18 Ordered to Europe (War not written on the official report (War Department)

1920 Apr 1 Was promoted to Lt. Col., Artillery (Cabinet)

1920 Jan 1 Appointed Chief Commissioner of the Peace Treaty

1920 Nov 1 Honored with the "Small Cordon of Rising Sun and was granted the sum of ¥2,100 (in recognition of war services of 1915 to 1920)

1922 Apr 1 Relieved of duty in the Inspectorate General of Military Training
Appointed Army Field Artillery Gunnery School Instructor

1922 Aug 15 Appointed Chief of Research Section of the Field Artillery Gunnery School; concurrently instructor of school (War Dept.)

1924 Feb 4 Promoted to the rank of Colonel, Artillery (Cabinet)

1924 Feb 4 Raised to 5th Court Rank, Junior Grade

1924 Feb 4 Relieved of all duty and placed on the waiting list (War Dept.)

1924 Feb 26 Placed on the reserve list (War Dept.)

1924 Mar 25 Raised to 5th Court Rank, Senior Grade

1922 Jan 31 Relieved as Executive Commissioner of the Peace Treaty (Cabinet)

1931 Dec 9 Assigned to the War Department

1931 Dec 9 Appointed to the retinue of the plenipotentiary to Disarmament Conference to be held at Geneva (Cabinet)

1933 Feb 4 Relieved from the post mentioned above (Cabinet)

1934 Apr 24 Raised to the 3rd Order of Merit of "Order of the Sacred Treasure (Cabinet) (In recognition of war services of 1931 to 1934)

- 1939 Aug 2 Appointed Councilor in the Department of Labor
- 1940 Apr 1 Placed on the retired list (War Department)
- 1940 Dec 10 Appointed Temporary Commissioner of Colonial Investigation Committee
- 1942 Nov 1 Appointed Councilor of the Labor Department
