I explained to Colonel Lee, of OPD, who prepared the military clauses for the Austrian treaty, that the Department of State had used only two of the Articles from the draft submitted by him. I inquired if he wished to have the entire draft put into SWNCC for consideration in view of the use which we had made of his proposed Articles. He replied that the War Department thought it would be a good idea to have the entire paper discussed in SWNCC and recommended that you sign the attached memorandum.

MEMORANDUM FOR SECRETARY, EUROPEAN SUB-COMMITTEE, SWNCC:

SUBJECT: Treaty with Austria

1. Subsequent to the original drafting of the report of SWNC Subcommittee for Europe on "Treaty with Austria" by the working group designated for this purpose, the objections to the accomplishment of bilateral agreement to cover the necessary rights and reservations respecting war dead of the United Nations in the European countries with which peace settlements are to be concluded, are considered to have been removed. Accordingly, it is desired to substitute in paragraph 15, Appendix "B" of the report of the SWNC Subcommittee for Europe on the Treaty with Austria, the same phraseology used in paragraph 14, Appendix "B", SWNCC 244/3 (revised 5 March 1946).

2. The Navy, Air and State members of the working group agree with this proposed change and the following should be substituted in the report previously submitted:

"15. Provisions for Graves and War Dead matters are required to cover the interests of the United Nations having graves or remains of war dead in these countries. It is desirable to provide for such arrangements by separate bilateral agreements between each of the United Nations concerned and Austria, if suitable arrangements can be established and concluded prior to the conclusion of the treaty. Otherwise, general provisions for multilateral application must be included."
