


- Active participation of the Scientific Culture and Innovation Unit (UCC+i) of the universities.

- Coordinated by Academic or Administrative staff through a wikitutor.
- Training and support for wikitutors from Wikimedia Spain.

60 articles published/improved.

5,4 articles per group.

0,46 articles for each estudent involved.

No Wikipedian professors.

# Wikipedia Club: Quality and depth



 7 collaborating professors from 3 public universities.

√ 4 Wikipedia clubs.

√ 39 students involved.

✓ 20 articles published/improved.

✓ 5 articles per group.

✓ 0,51 articles for each student involved.

√ 7 Wikipedian professors.





### Topic

Definition of subjects and search for collaborators to identify articles.



#### **Articles and sources**

Identify missing and improvable items. Scientific quality sources.



#### Outcomes

Continuous follow up and assessment of each club's work.



#### Credits and certificates

Credit recognition (RAC) and official recognition for students (through university), wikitutors (through Fundación Madri+d) and universities (through Wikimedia Spain).



#### Students search

PhDs, master's degrees, bachelor's degrees, etc.



## Workshop

On-site, remote or hybrid.
