The exceptions are, C'anvas, Tin Boxes for Oil Colors, amd books on Art, in all of which, in consequence of making them leading articles, competition has reduced the profits below a remmerative standard.

We think that we may, with justice, claim a superiority for the Bresues of our own manufacture, for which we have been awarded premiums by the "American Institute" of New York, in 1855, and the "Massachusetts Charitable Mechanics' Association " of Boston, in 1856, whilst for the other articles, we supply them of as goord qualities as any other house in the Trade.

In conclusion, we trust that this little book will be of mutual advantage to our patrons and to us.
