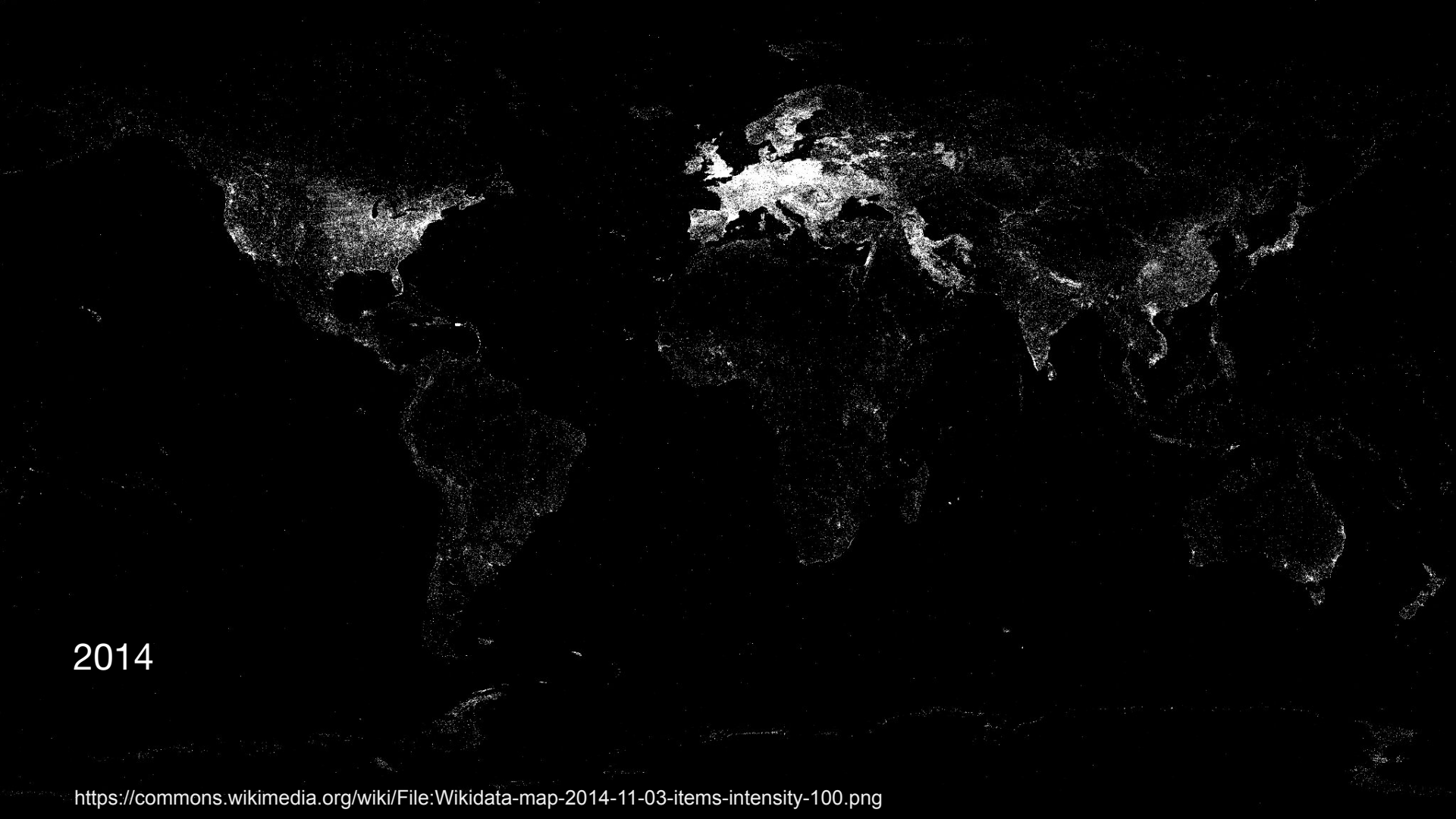

Data Contributions

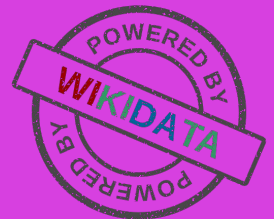
Organizations import data onto Wikidata, to increase visibility of the items via the Linked Open Data web.

Organizations reusing Wikidata's data for their projects.

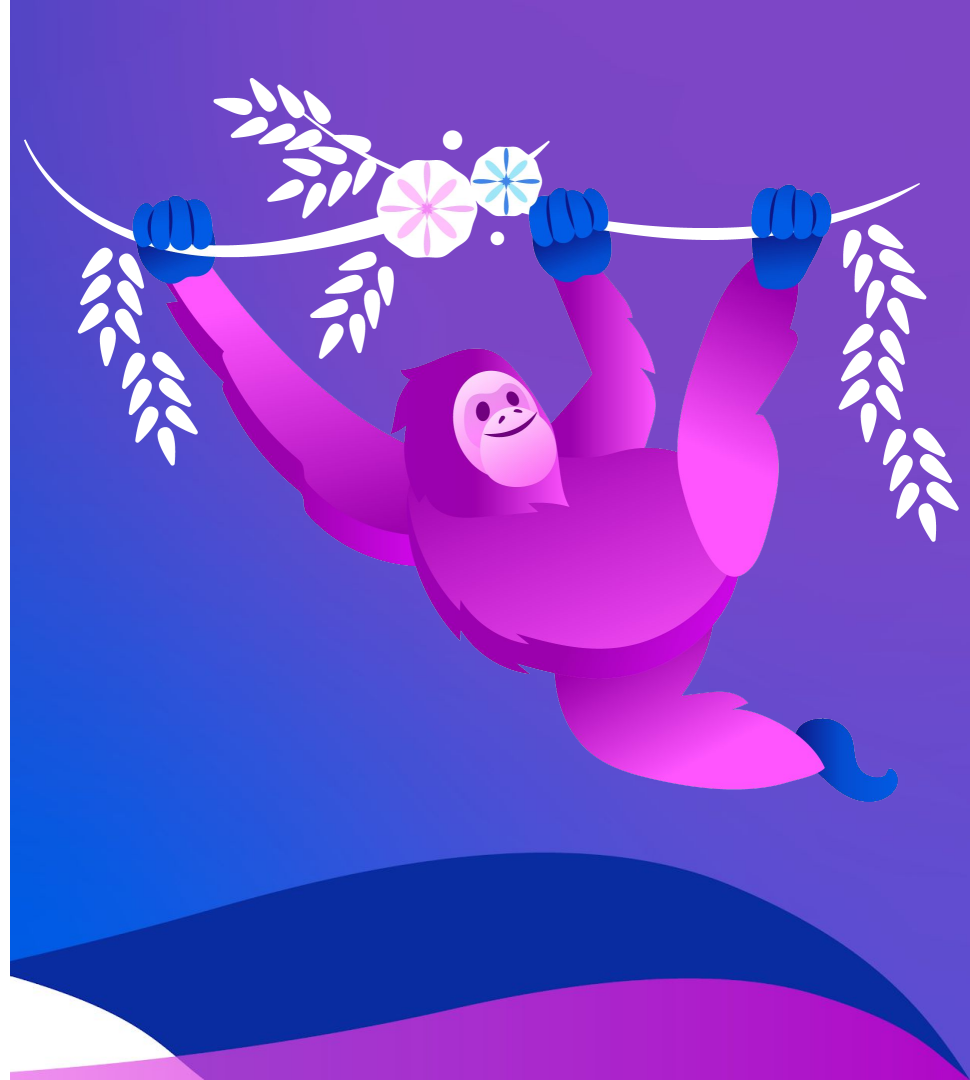

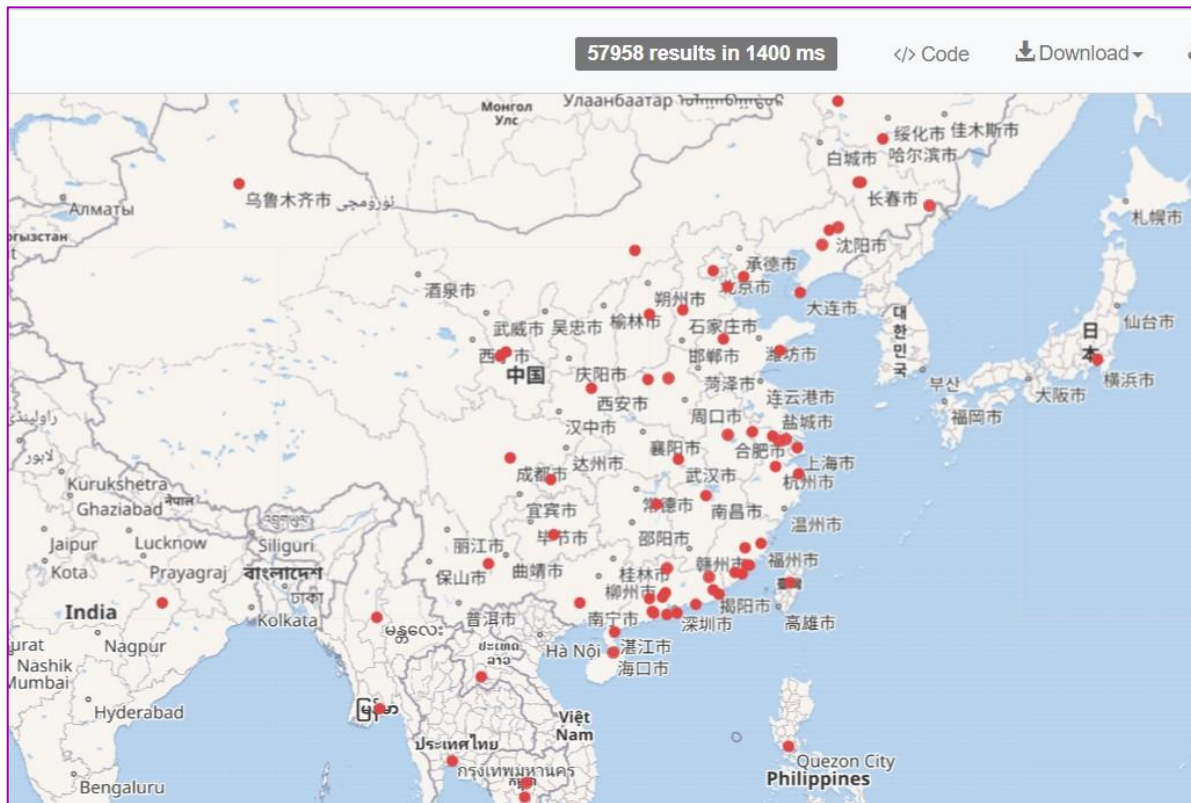

About Project

Background

- Started in 2018 ~ 2024 (see project page [here](#))
- Data contribution: historical press archives of ZBW, with millions of press clippings and other materials about persons, organizations, wares, events and general subjects. Arguably the world's most comprehensive public press archives in the 20th century.
- PM20 metadata is integrated into Wikidata, aiming at:
 - link all folders of the collection to Wikidata, providing access to sources to Wikimedia projects and the general public
 - add metadata from the folders (e.g., persons' birth dates) to the linked Wikidata items

About Project


- Ext ID Property: [PM20 Folder ID \(P4293\)](#) (proposed by an Admin of DE WP) to link PM20 Person and Company folder.
- Mix-n-Match catalog created and 60 Wikidata volunteers contributed
- E.g. Persons
 - 5266 folders - more than 6000 statements which are [sourced in PM20](#) (from "date of birth" to the track gauge of a Brazilian railway line); more than 1000 items, for which PM20 ID is the [only external identifier](#)
