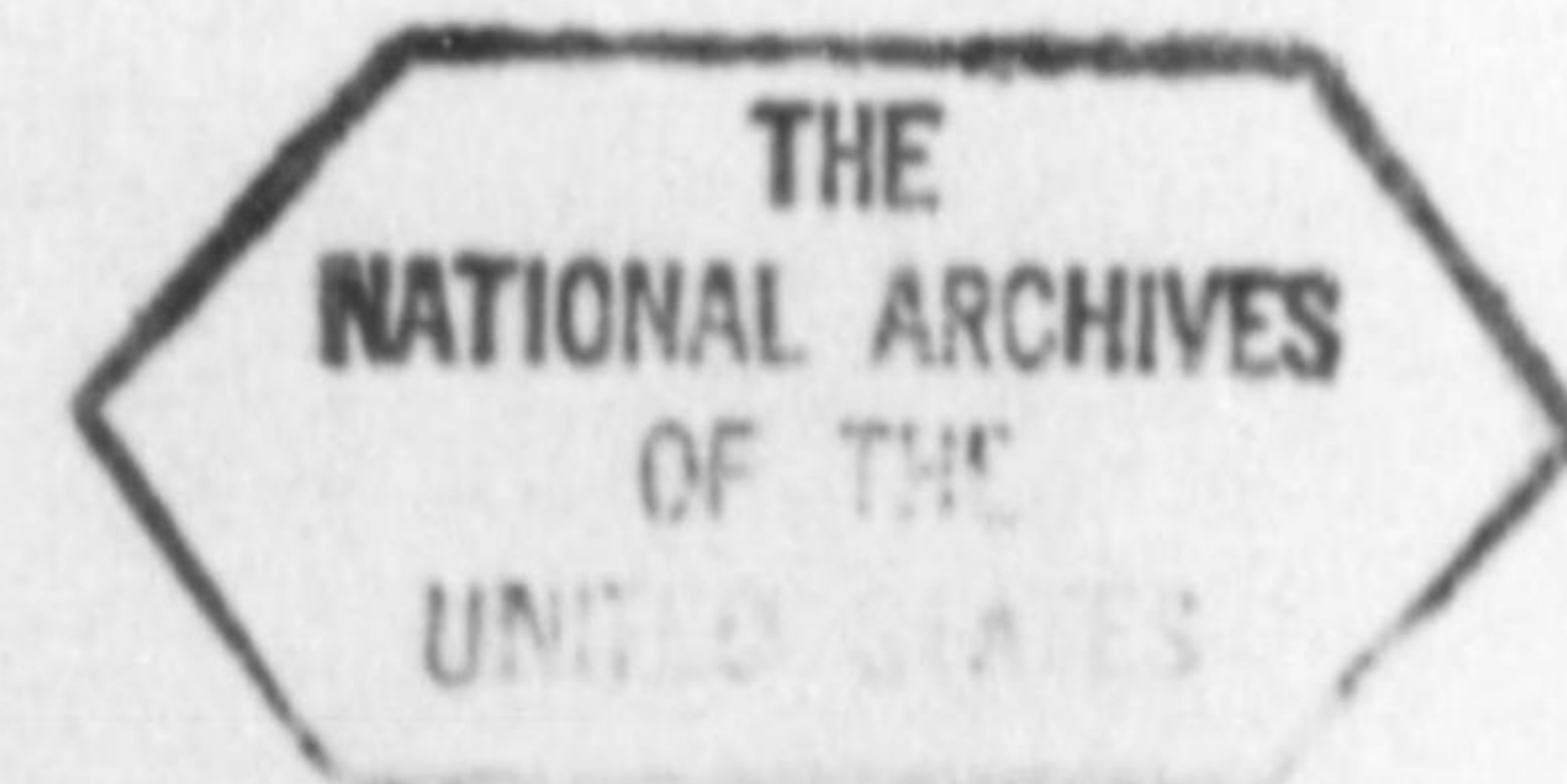



1. Reference is made to:


2. In order to aid in the proper filing and prompt delivery of
messages addressed to foreign vessels operating in waters adjacent to
Japan, the following procedures should be initiated:

a. An accurate daily list of all Allied ships reporting their
presence within operating range of the coastal radio stations listed in
reference 1a should be kept on file for ready reference at the Central
Telegraph Office in all major seaport cities. This list should contain
both the ship's name and the radio call sign.

b. All incoming messages delivered to addressees in Japan
should contain in the heading the name of the originating ship and the
radio call sign.

c. In the case of messages filed in Japan for delivery to
ships where the call sign is unknown or there is reasonable doubt as
to its accuracy, the name of the ship as filed by the originator should
be included in the regularly scheduled traffic lists designated in the
List of Japanese Ship and Coastal Radio Stations, Inclosure 2 to ref-
erence 1b.

3. The above procedures are necessary in view of the incomplete
and inaccurate international ship listings now available.
