

Article XIII. When the hearing of explanations of appellants or other persons concerned has been conducted by the Board, a record thereof shall be prepared.

Article XIII. The record shall be prepared by witnessing secretaries and signed and sealed by them as well as by the Chairman.

Article XIV. The provisions in the preceding two articles shall apply mutatis mutandis to the case of the hearing being conducted by one or more members ordered to do so in accordance with the provisions of Article IX.

Article XV. The result of examinations shall be decided at a session of the Board.

The decision prescribed in the preceding paragraph shall be put in the form of a written statement sealed by all the members concerned.

The statement of decision shall be drafted by the member in charge of each case.

Article XVI. The statement of decision shall be made out in the form separately fixed.

Article XVII. The Chairman shall report the contents of the statement of decision to the Prime Minister.

Article XVIII. Appeals not in accordance with the Imperial Ordinance No. 65 of 1947 or those filed without going through legal formalities may be dismissed.

Article XIX. The Board shall not re-examine one and the same case; provided, however, that this does not apply in the

case



case where the Prime Minister demands re-examination by presenting new corroborative data.

Article IX. In case unavoidable circumstances make it impossible to observe the present Regulations, the Chairman may, at his discretion, adopt appropriate measures.

SUBJECT : Public Office Qualifications Appeal Board.

1. The Supreme Commander has consistently recognized the propriety of appellate machinery within the Japanese Government to investigate and bring to light any injustice in the application of the Memorandum for the Japanese Government date 4 January 1946 (SCAPIN 550).

Accordingly, there is no fundamental objection to the continued existence of the Appeal Board in a purely advisory capacity.

2. It is desired, however, that no person who has been designated as falling under the Memorandum and thereby removed or barred from the public service be reinstated until his case, with a report of the appellate proceedings, has been submitted to this Headquarters for review and prior approval.

Dear Mr. Chief Justice:

This will confirm our conversation of even date wherein I pointed out that the removal of undesirable persons from public service is required by directive of the Supreme Commander of January 4, 1946, that the machinery and procedures for its implementation have been established with the approval of the Supreme Commander; that the Prime Minister is directly responsible to the Supreme Commander for all action taken pursuant there to; that the Supreme Commander, while leaving these matters general to the governmental process, reserves his inherent authority to intervene in any stage of any proceeding thereunder; and that as a consequence the Japanese courts are without jurisdiction over any removal or exclusion proceedings in implementation of the aforesaid directive.
