MEMORANDUM FOR: JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

SUBJECT: Separation Allowances for Government Employees

1. The Japanese Government is directed to take the necessary measures to establish standard allowances to be paid to Government employees separated from Government service consistent with the amount of funds provided for such allowances in the consolidated balanced budget adopted for the fiscal year 1949-50 in accordance with the United States Government Interim Directive on economic stabilization.

2. Pending establishment of standard allowances in conformity with the requirements of paragraph 1 above:

a. No payments of allowances to separated government employees of any class will be made upon the authority of the Law Concerning Appointment, Removal, etc. of Government Officials Before Application of the Provisions of National Public Service Law Shall Be Made, Law No. 121 of 1947, or the authority of any other statutory ratification of the standards for such allowances set by the Cabinet decision of 29 March 1947; and

b. No payments of allowances to separated employees of any class will be made under Law No. 157 of 1947 to employees who are eligible for allowances under the Pension Law, Law No. 48 of 1923, as amended, the National Public Service Mutual Aid Association Law, Law No. 69 of 1948, or the Unemployment Insurance Law, Law No. 146 of 1947.
