

### **CORE INTERACTION FLOW**


- 1. Reading an article and seeing an error (either in copy or a display bug).

- 4. Receive confirmation that the report was successfully posted.














Tap to highlight an area with an issue (either in copy or a display bug).






#### Tap on overflow for additional options on text selection menu






