to Miami on Friday 30 June, and [redacted] would phone [redacted] on July 5 for evaluation of "Rothman's operational potential in Cuban affairs."

McConnell spoke to [redacted] privately. [redacted] described himself as a "leading political figure in the Democratic Party machine in N. Carolina," that he was "acquainted @ Rob. Kennedy, Gen. Taylor, Gen. Van Fleet," corporate tax lawyer's concerned over embarrassment to the Kennedy administration caused by the Cuban "fiasco." [redacted] stated that Rothman claims to have assets and capabilities which would enable Rothman to destroy the arms dumps on the plantation of ex-pres. Cardenas of Mexico, to set up operational bases in the Yucatan at a cost of \$50 - \$1,000, to sabotage targets in Cuba identified by the U.S. gov't, and to provide positive intelligence on the activities of Chinese Communist groups in the Western Hemisphere."

Rothman stated @ Castro had executed 3 of his close friends: Rogelio Gonzalez; Sori Marin; Efigenio Fernandez.
