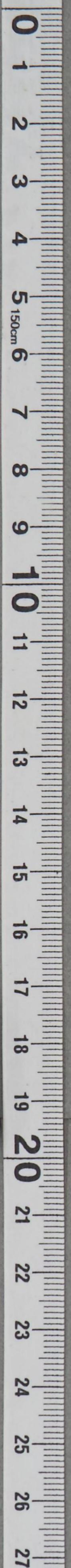

a. Paragraph 3, Section I, T/D 301-, should be changed to read "This unit, augmented by indigenous personnel, is capable of reproducing maps, photomaps, photographs, etc. by means of lithographic offset presses and charts, diagrams and printed matter by photostat machine as required by Japan Logistical Command. The unit, augmented by indigenous personnel, is capable of operating the Far East Command Map Depot."

b. No provision has been made in the detachment headquarters for personnel to perform routine administration and supply matters. It is noted that one clerk, general, one clerk, typist, and several supply MOSs are included in the Map Depot Section. However, it would place a heavy burden on this Section if its personnel were called upon to carry the administrative and supply load. It is recommended that a clerk, typist, MOS 4405, in the grade of corporal be authorized in Detachment Headquarters.

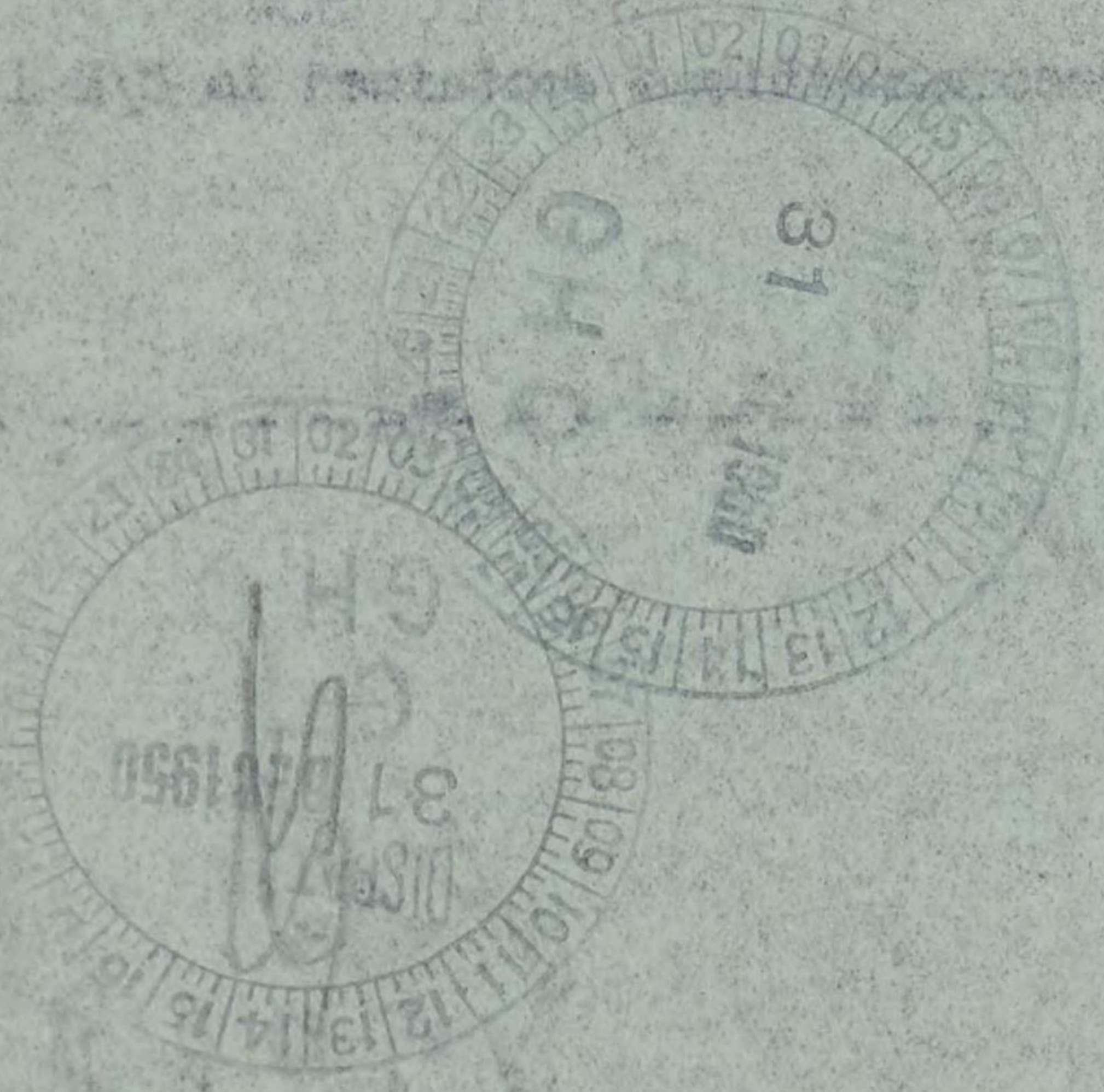

MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD:

Subject: T/D, Engr Topo Detachment, JLCOM

1. For additional background see G-4 JN 17121. In brief, the foregoing action concerned JLCOM ltr AGFC 322 to CINCFE, 28 Oct 50, requesting authority to activate an Engineer Map Depot Detachment for JLCOM. Informal information received by the Engr GHQ from the Engr JLCOM on 11 Nov 50 also indicated that JLCOM intended to request permission to activate a Map Reproduction Detachment. Based on this information the basic letter was returned to JLCOM on 20 Nov 50 requesting that a T/D for an Engr Topo Detachment be submitted to CINCFE providing spaces for both the Map Topo Detachment and the Map Reproduction personnel.

2. Engr C/N 1 to G-4, G-2 and G-3 on 30 Dec 50 forwarded a T/D for an Engr Topo Detachment as proposed by JLCOM. The proposed unit has an aggregate strength of 18 spaces. Engr concurred except for minor changes in the wording of the units capabilities and recommended the addition of one clerk-typist. This would make an aggregate strength of 19 for the unit.

3. G-2 has staff ~~action~~ responsibility for map distribution and is included as an addressee on the C/N.. CG JLCOM and Engr GHQ have both indicated a requirement for the unit so it is felt that G-4 should interpose no objections.

4. Recommend approval of C/N 2.

5. If this request is approved, it will increase Engr strength on hand and requisitioned from the DA from 33,384 to 33,403 as compared to an Engr slice of 33,484.

1. A review of Far East Command bulk allotment unit designations has revealed that some Table of Distribution units are not designated in accordance with the provisions of SR 220-5-20, 17 March 1950.

2. Each bulk allotment unit will be designated by an appropriate military title in keeping with, and descriptive of, the assigned mission of the unit and assigned an army unit number.

3. Each post, camp, station, or area command administered as a post, camp, or station is considered a parent unit and will be assigned an army unit number. Subordinate activities of such posts, camps, or stations administered as detachments will be assigned the same army unit number as the parent unit. Similar procedure will be followed in the case of a command-wide activity administered centrally but with detachments at several locations.

4. It is desired that the organization and designation of bulk allotment units in your respective commands be reviewed in the light of the foregoing and that they be redesignated appropriately in accordance with SR 220-5-20 and this letter.

5. a. In order to assist the commands in effecting the required redesignations, the following additional army unit numbers are assigned as indicated:

(1) Eighth Army: Army Unit Numbers 8206, 8075.

(2) Japan Logistical Command: Army Unit Numbers 8009, 8033, 8042, 8054, 8056, 8059, 8060, 8061, 8064, 8065, 8067, 8080, 8082, 8084, 8088, 8089, 8093, 8094, 8095, 8098.

1. Signal comments and recommendations regarding RYCOM Tables of Distribution are submitted in accordance with informal instructions from G-4 (Maj Tilton) as follows:

a. Total strength and allocation of officer and enlisted personnel within the RYCOM Signal Service, 8111th Army Unit are generally concurred in; however, some obvious errors in providing certain required administrative personnel and in establishing the grade structure for technical personnel are noted. SRs 650-165-1 and 650-185-1 establish grade authorization for the technicians in the career fields covered therein. Since grade structure of all T/O&E units is rigidly controlled by the principles set forth in appropriate SRs, it is recommended that T/D units be controlled likewise. Obvious discrepancies which should be corrected or justified under SR requirements prior to approval of TD 301-1711, 28 Oct 50, are as follows:

4. The organization for subject division was determined by experiences gained in present operations. It is organized for operation in such terrain as found in Korea and within the capabilities and limitations of the Korean soldiers. Since the organization is similar to the United States Army division the training doctrines of the United States Army can be readily employed with only minor changes to conform with local conditions.

5. General Headquarters, Far East Command has reviewed equipment allowances in detail with a view to elimination of equipment which is either not suitable for use by Korean personnel or not necessary to tactical operations in Korea. The number of vehicles may be excessive. This matter and the related question of whether vehicles for the ROK Army should be procured in Japan or the United States will be the subject of continuing study.

2. A proposed T/D which was submitted by JLCOM on 4 Sep 50 was considered excessive in strength. It requested an aggregate strength of 1154, so GHQ returned it to JLCOM for further consideration, justification and modification. At that time JLCOM was informed to form a hqs along the lines of a Hq Log Comd Type C. The aggregate strength of such a Log Comd is 602. JLCOM revised a proposed T/D and forwarded on 1 Nov 50 a new proposed T/D having aggregate strength of 875. The differences between the proposed 875 and the 602 of a Log Comd Type C was justified by the responsibility required of JLCOM in contrast to that normally assigned a Log Comd. These differences were listed in JLCOM's cover letter attached to the T/O&E and included such items as the operation of schools, care of dependent families, supervision of customs, immigration, railroads, ports, etc in areas the size of Japan.

3. On 1 Nov 50 the proposed T/D was circulated among all Tech Services GHQ for their comments and recommendations. By letter, AG 320.3 (13 Oct 50)GC-TC, subject T/D for War Crimes Division, this headquarters assigned operational responsibility for investigation and trial war criminals in War Crimes Division to be established in Judge Advocate Section, Eighth Army. Nine personnel recruited here as nucleus for this Division have departed this headquarters for Eighth Army. Screening of replacement stream here for qualified personnel will continue.

Part II. Number of war crimes revealed requires prompt and vigorous action be taken for thorough investigation of atrocities and apprehension and trial of perpetrators. Centralization of investigative effort and rapid follow up of leads gathered by lower units vital in securing details. It is most urgent that immediate steps be taken to expand the War Crimes Division with such additional qualified personnel as may be available within your command. Every effort consistent with the tactical situation should be made to provide necessary facilities such as transportation, office and field equipment, and protection of investigative personnel in order that they may carry out their assigned mission.
