
2. In order to assist commanders concerned in carrying out Phase III of the atomic energy indoctrination program, it is now contemplated that the instructional material referred to in paragraph 5, reference paragraph 1, above, will be given wider distribution throught the Army to include distribution to units of company level in the Regular Army, and comparable distribution within the Reserve Components of the Army. This material will consist of one Department of the Army pamphlet containing instructor guidance material (including lecture outlines) in sufficient scope to permit the conduct of the prescribed training. However, delays necessitated by review, printing, and distribution time are such as to make this publication unavailable prior to approximately 15 September 1950.

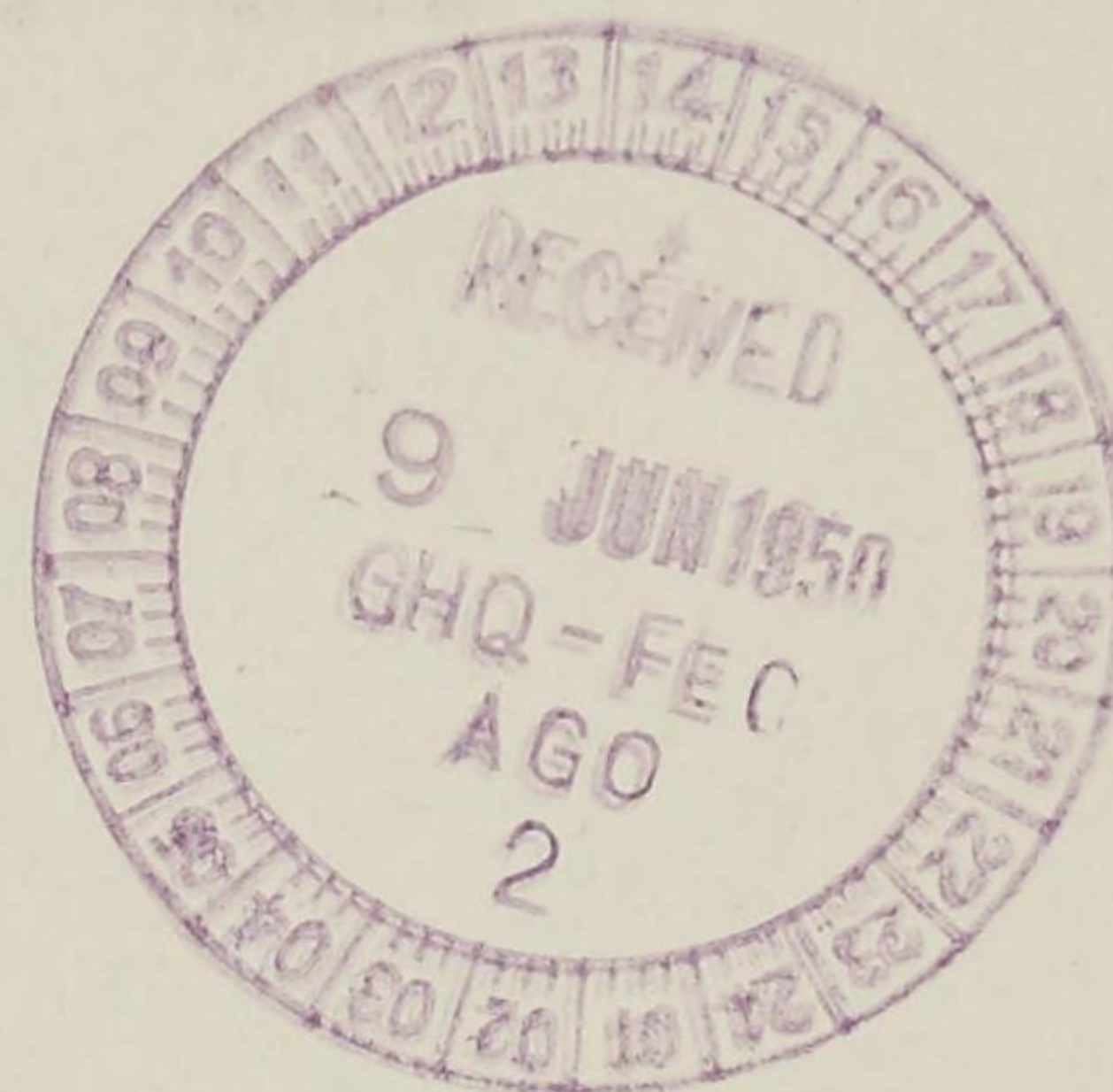
