: Registration of Ryukyuans

1. Reference is made to:

a. Memorandum for the Imperial Japanese Government, subject and file number as above, (SCAPIN 746) dated 17 February 1946.

b. Memorandum of Central Liaison Office, No. 1616 (RF) dated 7 April 1946, subject: "Registration of Koreans, Chinese, Ryukyuans and Formosans."

- 2. Information has been received that the number of Ryukyuans, reported in reference, paragraph 1 b above, as desirous of repatriation does not reflect the true situation txisting in Japan at the present time.
- 3. The Imperial Japanese Government will revise data pertaining to Ryukyuans contained in reference, paragraph 1 b above, to show accurately the current situation in Japan.
- 4. The report will include the total number of Ryukyuans now resident in Japan desirous of repatriation, excluding those who have moved to repatriation centers, broken down to show sub-totals by present location in Japan and destination in the Ryukyus.
- 5. The report will indicate the situation as of 1 October 1946, and will be submitted prior to 20 October 1946.
