- l. The purpose of this dispatch is to report on a case involving one of the Finnish employees at the American Dabassy, Barry Alfons SUNDVIK. He has been employed as a chauffeur/clerk in the Cemeral Services Section of the Embassy since 1951 and presently is in charge of the Unclassified Rail Boom. His duties also include arranging travel documents for U. 5. Explosatic courage between Helsinki and Moscow and hence he has reason to virit the Soviet Embassy from time to time. Recently the sabesay General Services Officer brought his suspicions to the attention of Roodine, saying that they were based on Sundvik's general attitude, portionlarly after the latter had expressed his interest in making a trip to the Soviet Union and his taking Massian lessons for this purpose. The CSO also reported that Sundvik was known to have talked a number of times with Soviet Vice Consul Anatolij Klimov while on routine business at the Soviet Enhancy. These points led to the screening of fundvik's personnel file (with the concurrence of the Charge d'Affaires) and to a obeak of the references be had given on his employment application. The latter turned cut to be quite shady. According to the VALIRES two of the three are listed as baving a number of arrests each, including meastanghter, drunkenness, thaft, etc., and the third could not be identified. These obviously were not investigated wary closely at the time Sundvik applied for employment. On 5 April Vallick surveillance was placed on Sundvik (again with the Charge's concurrence). He was followed each evening after he left the Ambasey and on 10 April. after it was learned that Sundvik was driving to the Soviet Union for a four-day trip. he was followed from Terwokoeki to the Firsish-Soviet border point at Vanliman. Two VALLER detectives were on hand here to observe the exceeding. They reported a routine border orossing, that no customs inspection was made, and that Sundvik met two Soviet Soldiers at the border station (on the Soviet side) before emtinging from there. He drove off following the soldiers' per. The circumstances of the border crossing are suspicious in teat he ornesed the border alone, in his own automobile, in bad weather, and for only four days. They also compare closely to the Alanko case where Alanko was asked by the Sovieta to rent a car, louve his family on the Finnish side (Lappeanumta) and crosm the border alone for a short trip. On Sundvik's return trip 15 Ajril he was again followed from the border to Terwakoski, and them to Helvinki where day to day surveillance continued. Attached are translations of the VALIBE surveillance reports and a report of the border crossing which we have received to date. The weekend prior to his trip into the USSR Sundvik spent in Torvakoski with his fishese, hence there are no reports covering this period.
 - 2. We have now learned from the travel lists which we get every two weeks and which list all travelers going to and coming from the Soviet Union that Aratolij Klimov went to the USSR on 9 April, crossing the border at Vainikkaia (railroad erosaing point). Whether he has returned to Finland we do not know at this point. Since Klimov's travel coincides with Sundvik's, it is possible that there is some connection.
